

Blood

When we look at the scriptures and the complete Law/Torah/Teaching of Yahweh we find things not in the 10 Commandments that can cause us to lose our lives. Just like the 7th Day Sabbath, these laws were there before YHWH wrote on the tables.

One of these laws is the prohibition of eating the blood. That did not go away when Yahshua came, the same as the 10 Commandments did not go away. Many are deceived to think they can eat anything they want after Yahshua came, but that is simply not true. Many think they are without law but yet this law remains, so it is impossible to be without law.

In Acts, Moses was preached in all the synagogues, the Gentiles knew the Law of Moses, and they also knew the 10 Commandments, the Law of YHWH. Here we have the Hebrew apostles declaring the gentiles do not need to do the works of the Law of Moses and circumcision, BUT this was not a letter to abrogate the 10 Commandments but Moses. What was fully remaining was even before Moses, the **abstaining** from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and **from things strangled, and from blood.**

Eating the blood, the life of the being/soul will cause you to be cast into the lake of fire. The life of the one eating the blood IS required for that transgression.

Do not be deceived YHWH is NO respecter of persons, Jew, Israelite, Gentile are ALL the same, ALL sin is the same for ALL people, Transgression of the 10 Commandments, fornication, eating blood, meddling in things of idols are sins unto death. There is NO place for these things in the lives of the children of YHWH.

Genesis 9:1 And Elohim blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth.

Genesis 9:2 And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be upon every beast of the earth, and upon every fowl of the air, upon all that moves upon the earth, and upon all the fishes of the sea; into your hand are they delivered.

Genesis 9:3 Every moving thing that lives shall be food for you; even as the green herb have I given you all things.

Genesis 9:4 **But flesh with the life thereof, which is the blood thereof, shall you not eat.**

Genesis 9:5 And surely your blood of your lives will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I require the life of man.

Jubilees 6

5 'And you, increase you and multiply upon the earth, and become many upon it, and be a blessing upon it. The fear of you and the dread of you I will inspire in everything that is on earth and in the sea.

6 And behold I have given unto you all beasts, and all winged things, and everything that moves on the earth, and the fish in the waters, and all things for food; as the green herbs, I have given you all things to eat.

7 **But flesh, with the life thereof, with the blood, you shall not eat; for the life of all flesh is in the blood, lest your blood of your lives be required.** At the hand of every man, at the hand of every (beast) will I require the blood of man.

10 And Noah and his sons swore that they would not eat any blood that was in any flesh, and he made a covenant before YAHWEH forever throughout all the generations of the earth in this month.

11 On this account He spoke to you that you should make a covenant with the children of Yisrael in this month upon the mountain with an oath, and that you should sprinkle blood upon them because of all the words of the covenant, which YAHWEH made with them forever.

12 And this testimony is written concerning you that you should observe it continually, so **that you should not eat on any day any blood of beasts or birds or cattle during all the days of the earth,** and the man who eats the blood of beast or of cattle or of birds during all the days of the earth, he and his seed shall be rooted out of the land.

13 And do you command the children of Yisrael to eat no blood, so that their names and their seed may be before YAHWEH our Sovereign Ruler continually.

14 And for **this Torah there is no limit of days, for it is forever.** They shall observe it throughout their generations, so that they may continue supplicating on your behalf with blood before the altar; every day and at the time of morning and evening they shall seek forgiveness on your behalf perpetually before YAHWEH that they may keep it and not be rooted out.

Acts 15:7 And when there had been much disputing, Peter rose up, and said unto them, Men and brethren, you know how that a good while ago YHWH made choice among us, that the Gentiles by my mouth should hear the word of the gospel, and believe.

Acts 15:8 And YHWH, which knows the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Spirit, even as he did unto us;

Acts 15:9 And **put no difference between us and them**, purifying their hearts by faith.

Acts 15:10 Now therefore why tempt you YHWH, to put a yoke upon the neck of the disciples, which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear?

Acts 15:11 But we believe that through the grace of the Master Yahshua the Messiah we shall be saved, even as they.

Acts 15:12 Then all the multitude kept silence, and gave audience to Barnabas and Paul, declaring what miracles and wonders YHWH had wrought among the Gentiles by them.

Acts 15:13 And after they had held their peace, James answered, saying, Men and brethren, hearken unto me:

Acts 15:14 Simeon (Peter) has declared how YHWH at the first did visit the Gentiles, to take out of them a people for his name.

Acts 15:15 And to this agree the words of the prophets; as it is written,

Acts 15:16 *After this I will return, and will build again the tabernacle of David, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up:*

Acts 15:17 *That the residue of men might seek after YHWH, and all the Gentiles, upon whom my name is called, said YHWH, who does all these things.* Amos 9:11-12

Acts 15:18 Known are all the works of YHWH from the beginning of the world.

Acts 15:19 Wherefore my sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to YHWH:

Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they **abstain** from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and **from things strangled, and from blood.**

Acts 15:21 For Moses of old time has in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every sabbath day.

Acts 15:22 Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; namely, Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the brethren:

Acts 15:23 And they wrote letters by them after this manner; The apostles and elders and brethren send greeting unto the brethren which are of the Gentiles in Antioch and Syria and Cilicia:

Acts 15:24 Forasmuch as we have heard, that certain which went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls, saying, You must be circumcised, and keep the law: to whom we gave no such commandment:

Acts 15:25 It seemed good unto us, being assembled with one accord, to send chosen men unto you with our beloved Barnabas and Paul,

Acts 15:26 Men that have hazarded their lives for the name of our Master Yahshua the Messiah.

Acts 15:27 We have sent therefore Judas and Silas, who shall also tell you the same things by mouth.

Acts 15:28 For it seemed good to the Holy Spirit, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things;

Acts 15:29 That you **abstain** from meats offered to idols, and **from blood**, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if you keep yourselves, you shall do well. Fare you well.

Acts 21:23 Do therefore this that we say to you: We have four men which have a vow on them;

Acts 21:24 Them take, and purify thyselves with them, and be at charges with them, that they may shave their heads: and all may know that those things, whereof they were informed concerning you, are nothing; but that you thyselves also walk orderly, and keep the law.

Acts 21:25 As touching the Gentiles which believe, we have written and concluded that they observe no such thing, save only that they keep themselves from things offered to idols, and from blood, and from strangled, and from fornication.

Acts 21:26 Then Paul took the men, and the next day purifying himself with them entered into the temple, to signify the accomplishment of the days of purification, until that an offering should be offered for every one of them.

Acts 21:27 And when the seven days were almost ended, the Jews which were of Asia, when they saw him in the temple, stirred up all the people, and laid hands on him,

Acts 21:28 Crying out, Men of Israel, help: This is the man, that teach all men everywhere against the people, and the law, and this place: and further brought Greeks also into the temple, and has polluted this holy place.

Acts 21:29 (For they had seen before with him in the city Trophimus an Ephesian, whom they supposed that Paul had brought into the temple.)

Acts 21:30 And all the city was moved, and the people ran together: and they took Paul, and drew him out of the temple: and forthwith the doors were shut.
