G2316 θεός **theos** (the-os') *n.* **God**

G2424 Ἰησοῦς **Iesous** (yee-sous') *n/p.* **Jesus**

G5547 Χριστός **Christos** (chriy-stos') *n/p.* **Christ**

There are 202 verses with θεός **theos** [**God**] and Ἰησοῦς **Iesous** [**Jesus**] in the same verse and 116 of those verses with θεός **theos** [**God**], Ἰησοῦς **Iesous** [**Jesus**] and Χριστός **Christos** [**Christ**] in the same verse.

Peter wrote in the same type of context as Paul, in 2Peter 1:1 and he is NOT calling Jesus God because in the very next verse he completely separates the θεός **theos** from Ἰησοῦς **Iesous**.

In 1Peter 2:5 we see we have acceptable spiritual sacrifices to θεός **theos** BY Ἰησοῦς **Iesous**. Not in the WHOLE of the New Testament does it EVER call Jesus θεός **theos**, no not once.

YHWH is not a mystery, Yeshua is no longer a mystery, when he laid down his glory and came here as a man born of a woman, the mystery of the Messiah was revealed to mankind, he was the Lamb of YHWH slain from the foundation of the world for the whole world to be redeemed to YHWH or Yah the Almighty Great El, the one that had the power to create, the one that through Jesus created all things, ALL coming FROM YHWH through/by Yeshua who was the BEGINNING of creation. There is NO such thing as 'very God and very man' that is a made up fable with NO scripture to back it up.

1Pet 2:5 Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to **God** by **Jesus Christ**.

2Pet 1:1 Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of **Jesus Christ**, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of **God** and our Saviour **Jesus Christ**:

2Pet 1:2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of **God**, and of **Jesus** our Lord,

Titus 2:13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great **God** and our Saviour **Jesus Christ**;

Matt 3:16 And **Jesus**, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of **God** descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

Matt 4:7 **Jesus** said unto him, *It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy **God**.*

Matt 4:10 Then saith **Jesus** unto him, *Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy **God**, and him only shalt thou serve.*

Matt 8:29 And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with thee, **Jesus**, thou Son of **God**? art thou come hither to torment us before the time?

Matt 19:26 But **Jesus** beheld *them*, and said unto them, *With men this is impossible; but with **God** all things are possible.*

**Matt 21:12** And **Jesus** went into the temple of **God**, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves,

**Matt 21:31** Whether of them twain did the will of *his father*? They say unto him, The first. **Jesus** saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That the publicans and the harlots go into the kingdom of **God** before you.

**Matt 22:29** **Jesus** answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of **God**.

**Matt 22:37** **Jesus** said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy **God** with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

**Matt 26:63** But **Jesus** held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living **God**, that thou tell us whether thou be the **Christ**, the Son of **God**.

**Matt 27:46** And about the ninth hour **Jesus** cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My **God**, my **God**, why hast thou forsaken me?

**Matt 27:54** Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching **Jesus**, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of **God**.

**Mark 1:1** The beginning of the gospel of **Jesus Christ**, the Son of **God**;

**Mark 1:14** Now after that John was put in prison, **Jesus** came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of **God**,

**Mark 1:24** Saying, Let *us* alone; what have we to do with thee, thou **Jesus** of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy us? **I know thee who thou art, the Holy One of God.**

**Mark 5:7** And cried with a loud voice, and said, What have I to do with thee, **Jesus**, *thou Son of the most high God*? I adjure thee by **God**, that thou torment me not.

**Mark 10:14** But when **Jesus** saw *it*, he was much displeased, and said unto them, *Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.*

**Mark 10:18** And **Jesus** said unto him, *Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God.*

**Mark 10:23** And **Jesus** looked round about, and saith unto his disciples, *How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God!*

**Mark 10:24** And the disciples were astonished at his words. But **Jesus** answereth again, and saith unto them, *Children, how hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into the kingdom of God!*

**Mark 10:27** And **Jesus** looking upon them saith, *With men it is impossible, but not with God: for with God all things are possible.*

**Mark 11:22** And **Jesus** answering saith unto them, *Have faith in God.*

**Mark 12:17** And **Jesus** answering said unto them, Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to **God** the things that are **God**'s. And they marvelled at him.

**Mark 12:24** And **Jesus** answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of **God**?

**Mark 12:29** And **Jesus** answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our **God** is one Lord:

**Mark 12:34** And when **Jesus** saw that he answered discreetly, he said unto him, Thou art not far from the kingdom of **God**. And no man after that durst ask him *any question*.

**Mark 15:34** And at the ninth hour **Jesus** cried with a loud voice, saying, Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani? which is, being interpreted, My **God**, my **God**, why hast thou forsaken me?

**Mark 15:43** Joseph of Arimathaea, an honourable counsellor, which also waited for the kingdom of **God**, came, and went in boldly unto Pilate, and craved the body of **Jesus**.

**Luke 2:52** And **Jesus** increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with **God** and man.

**Luke 4:4** And **Jesus** answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of **God**.

**Luke 4:8** And **Jesus** answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy **God**, and him only shalt thou serve.

**Luke 4:12** And **Jesus** answering said unto him, It is said, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy **God**.

**Luke 4:34** Saying, Let us alone; what have we to do with thee, thou **Jesus** of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art; the Holy One of **God**.

**Luke 8:28** When he saw **Jesus**, he cried out, and fell down before him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with thee, **Jesus**, thou Son of **God** most high? I beseech thee, torment me not.

**Luke 8:39** Return to thine own house, and shew how great things **God** hath done unto thee. And he went his way, and published throughout the whole city how great things **Jesus** had done unto him.

**Luke 9:43** And they were all amazed at the mighty power of **God**. But while they wondered every one at all things which **Jesus** did, he said unto his disciples,

**Luke 9:60** **Jesus** said unto him, Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach the kingdom of **God**.

**Luke 9:62** And **Jesus** said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of **God**.

**Luke 18:16** But **Jesus** called them *unto him*, and said, Suffer little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of **God**.

**Luke 18:19** And **Jesus** said unto him, Why callest thou me good? none is good, save one, that is, **God**.

**Luke 18:24** And when **Jesus** saw that he was very sorrowful, he said, **How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God!**

**Luke 24:19** And he said unto them, **What things?** And they said unto him, Concerning **Jesus** of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in deed and word before **God** and all the people:

**John 1:29** The next day John seeth **Jesus** coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of **God**, which taketh away the sin of the world.

**John 1:36** And looking upon **Jesus** as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of **God!**

**John 3:2** The same came to **Jesus** by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from **God**: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except **God** be with him.

**John 3:3** **Jesus** answered and said unto him, **Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.**

**John 3:5** **Jesus** answered, **Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.**

**John 4:10** **Jesus** answered and said unto her, **If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.**

**John 6:29** **Jesus** answered and said unto them, **This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.**

**John 8:42** **Jesus** said unto them, **If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me.**

**John 8:54** **Jesus** answered, **If I honour myself, my honour is nothing: it is my Father that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God:**

**John 9:3** **Jesus** answered, **Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.**

**John 9:35** **Jesus** heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, **Dost thou believe on the Son of God?**

**John 10:34** **Jesus** answered them, **Is it not written in your law, I said, Ye are Gods?**

**John 11:4** When **Jesus** heard *that*, he said, **This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God might be glorified thereby.**

**John 11:40** **Jesus** saith unto her, **Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God?**

**John 13:3** **Jesus** knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from **God**, and went to **God**;

**John 13:31** Therefore, when he was gone out, **Jesus** said, **Now is the Son of man glorified, and God is glorified in him.**

**John 17:3** And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true **God**, and **Jesus Christ**, whom thou hast sent.

**John 20:17** **Jesus** saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my **God**, and your **God**.

**John 20:31** But these are written, that ye might believe that **Jesus** is the **Christ**, the Son of **God**; and that believing ye might have life through his name.

**Acts 2:22** Ye men of Israel, hear these words; **Jesus** of Nazareth, a man approved of **God** among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which **God** did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know:

**Acts 2:32** This **Jesus** hath **God** raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.

**Acts 2:36** Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that **God** hath made that same **Jesus**, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and **Christ**.

**Acts 3:13** The **God** of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the **God** of our fathers, hath glorified his Son **Jesus**; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let *him* go.

**Acts 3:26** Unto you first **God**, having raised up his Son **Jesus**, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.

**Acts 4:10** Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of **Jesus Christ** of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom **God** raised from the dead, *even* by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

**Acts 5:30** The **God** of our fathers raised up **Jesus**, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.

**Acts 7:45** Which also our fathers that came after brought in with **Jesus** into the possession of the Gentiles, whom **God** drave out before the face of our fathers, unto the days of David;

**Acts 7:55** But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of **God**, and **Jesus** standing on the right hand of **God**.

**Acts 8:12** But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of **God**, and the name of **Jesus Christ**, they were baptized, both men and women.

**Acts 8:37** And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that **Jesus Christ** is the Son of **God**.

**Acts 10:38** How **God** anointed **Jesus** of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for **God** was with him.

**Acts 11:17** Forasmuch then as **God** gave them the like gift as *he did* unto us, who believed on the Lord **Jesus Christ**; what was I, that I could withstand **God**?

**Acts 13:23** Of this man's seed hath **God** according to *his* promise raised unto Israel a Saviour, **Jesus**:

**Acts 13:33** **God** hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up **Jesus** again; as it is also written in the second psalm, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee.

**Acts 20:21** Testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, repentance toward **God**, and faith toward our Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**Acts 20:24** But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord **Jesus**, to testify the gospel of the grace of **God**.

**Acts 28:23** And when they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into *his* lodging; to whom he expounded and testified the kingdom of **God**, persuading them concerning **Jesus**, both out of the law of Moses, and *out of* the prophets, from morning till evening.

**Acts 28:31** Preaching the kingdom of **God**, and teaching those things which concern the Lord **Jesus Christ**, with all confidence, no man forbidding him.

**Rom 1:1** Paul, a servant of **Jesus Christ**, called *to be* an apostle, separated unto the gospel of **God**,

**Rom 1:7** To all that be in Rome, beloved of **God**, called *to be* saints: Grace to you and peace from **God** our Father, and the Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**Rom 1:8** First, I thank my **God** through **Jesus Christ** for you all, that your faith is spoken of throughout the whole world.

**Rom 2:16** In the day when **God** shall judge the secrets of men by **Jesus Christ** according to my gospel.

**Rom 3:22** Even the righteousness of **God** *which is* by faith of **Jesus Christ** unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:

**Rom 5:1** Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with **God** through our Lord **Jesus Christ**:

**Rom 5:11** And not only *so*, but we also joy in **God** through our Lord **Jesus Christ**, by whom we have now received the atonement.

**Rom 5:15** But not as the offence, so also *is* the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace of **God**, and the gift by grace, *which is* by one man, **Jesus Christ**, hath abounded unto many.

**Rom 6:11** Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto **God** through **Jesus Christ** our Lord.

**Rom 6:23** For the wages of sin *is* death; but the gift of **God** *is* eternal life through **Jesus Christ** our Lord.

**Rom 7:25** I thank **God** through **Jesus Christ** our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of **God**; but with the flesh the law of sin.

**Rom 8:39** Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of **God**, which is in **Christ Jesus** our Lord.

**Rom 10:9** That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord **Jesus**, and shalt believe in thine heart that **God** hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

**Rom 15:5** Now the **God** of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to **Christ Jesus**:

**Rom 15:6** That ye may with one mind *and* one mouth glorify **God**, even the Father of our Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**Rom 15:8** Now I say that **Jesus Christ** was a minister of the circumcision for the truth of **God**, to confirm the promises *made* unto the fathers:

**Rom 15:16** That I should be the minister of **Jesus Christ** to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of **God**, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by the Holy Ghost.

**Rom 15:17** I have therefore whereof I may glory through **Jesus Christ** in those things which pertain to **God**.

**Rom 15:30** Now I beseech you, brethren, for the Lord **Jesus Christ**'s sake, and for the love of the Spirit, that ye strive together with me in *your* prayers to **God** for me;

**Rom 16:20** And the **God** of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord **Jesus Christ** *be* with you. Amen.

**Rom 16:27** To **God only wise, be glory through Jesus Christ** for ever. Amen.

**1Cor 1:1** Paul, called *to be* an apostle of **Jesus Christ** through the will of **God**, and Sosthenes *our* brother,

**1Cor 1:2** Unto the church of **God** which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in **Christ Jesus**, called *to be* saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of **Jesus Christ** our Lord, both theirs and ours:

**1Cor 1:3** Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from **God** our Father, and *from* the Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**1Cor 1:4** I thank my **God** always on your behalf, for the grace of **God** which is given you by **Jesus Christ**;

**1Cor 1:9** **God** *is* faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son **Jesus Christ** our Lord.

**1Cor 1:30** But of him are ye in **Christ Jesus**, who of **God** is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

**1Cor 6:11** And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord **Jesus**, and by the Spirit of our **God**.

**1Cor 8:6** But to us *there is but* one **God**, the Father, of whom *are* all things, and we in him; and one Lord **Jesus Christ**, by whom *are* all things, and we by him.

**1Cor 12:3** Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of **God** calleth **Jesus** accursed: and *that* no man can say that **Jesus** is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.

**1Cor 15:57** But thanks *be* to **God**, which giveth us the victory through our Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**2Cor 1:1** Paul, an apostle of **Jesus Christ** by the will of **God**, and Timothy *our* brother, unto the church of **God** which is at Corinth, with all the saints which are in all Achaia:

**2Cor 1:2** Grace *be* to you and peace from **God** our Father, and *from* the Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**2Cor 1:3** Blessed *be* **God**, even the Father of our Lord **Jesus Christ**, the Father of mercies, and the **God** of all comfort;

**2Cor 1:19** For the Son of **God**, **Jesus Christ**, who was preached among you by us, *even* by me and Silvanus and Timotheus, was not yea and nay, but in him was yea.

**2Cor 4:6** For **God**, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to *give* the light of the knowledge of the glory of **God** in the face of **Jesus Christ**.

**2Cor 5:18** And all things *are* of **God**, who hath reconciled us to himself by **Jesus Christ**, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;

**2Cor 11:31** The **God** and Father of our Lord **Jesus Christ**, which is blessed for evermore, knoweth that I lie not.

**2Cor 13:14** The grace of the Lord **Jesus Christ**, and the love of **God**, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, *be* with you all. Amen.

**Gal 1:1** Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by **Jesus Christ**, and **God the Father, who raised him from the dead**);

**Gal 1:3** Grace *be* to you and peace from **God** the Father, and *from* our Lord **Jesus Christ**,

**Gal 3:26** For ye are all the children of **God** by faith in **Christ Jesus**.

**Gal 4:14** And my temptation which was in my flesh ye despised not, nor rejected; but received me as an angel of **God**, *even* as **Christ Jesus**.

**Eph 1:1** Paul, an apostle of **Jesus Christ** by the will of **God**, to the saints which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in **Christ Jesus**:

**Eph 1:2** Grace *be* to you, and peace, from **God** our Father, and *from* the Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**Eph 1:3** Blessed *be* the **God** and Father of our Lord **Jesus Christ**, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly *places* in **Christ**:

**Eph 1:17** That the **God** of our Lord **Jesus Christ**, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

**Eph 2:10** For we are his workmanship, created in **Christ Jesus** unto good works, which **God** hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

**Eph 3:9** And to make all *men* see what *is* the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in **God**, who created all things by **Jesus Christ**:



**Eph 5:20** Giving thanks always for all things unto **God** and the Father in the name of our Lord **Jesus Christ**;

**Eph 6:23** Peace *be* to the brethren, and love with faith, from **God** the Father and the Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**Phil 1:2** Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from **God** our Father, and *from* the Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**Phil 1:8** For **God** is my record, how greatly I long after you all in the bowels of **Jesus Christ**.

**Phil 1:11** Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by **Jesus Christ**, unto the glory and praise of **God**.

**Phil 2:11** And *that* every tongue should confess that **Jesus Christ** is Lord, to the glory of **God** the Father.

**Phil 3:3** For we are the circumcision, which worship **God** in the spirit, and rejoice in **Christ Jesus**, and have no confidence in the flesh.

**Phil 3:14** I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of **God** in **Christ Jesus**.

**Phil 4:7** And the peace of **God**, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through **Christ Jesus**.

**Phil 4:19** But my **God** shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by **Christ Jesus**.

**Col 1:1** Paul, an apostle of **Jesus Christ** by the will of **God**, and Timotheus *our* brother,

**Col 1:2** To the saints and faithful brethren in **Christ** which are at Colosse: Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from **God** our Father and the Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**Col 1:3** We give thanks to **God** and the Father of our Lord **Jesus Christ**, praying always for you,

**Col 3:17** And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord **Jesus**, giving thanks to **God** and the Father by him.

**Col 4:11** And **Jesus**, which is called Justus, who are of the circumcision. These only *are* my fellowworkers unto the kingdom of **God**, which have been a comfort unto me.

**1Thess 1:1** Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians *which* is in **God** the Father and *in* the Lord **Jesus Christ**: Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from **God** our Father, and the Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**1Thess 1:3** Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of hope in our Lord **Jesus Christ**, in the sight of **God** and our Father;

**1Thess 2:14** For ye, brethren, became followers of the churches of **God** which in Judaea are in **Christ Jesus**: for ye also have suffered like things of your own countrymen, even as they *have* of the Jews:

**1Thess 2:15** Who both killed the Lord **Jesus**, and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they please not **God**, and are contrary to all men:

**1Thess 3:11** Now **God** himself and our Father, and our Lord **Jesus Christ**, direct our way unto you.

**1Thess 3:13** To the end he may stablish your hearts unblameable in holiness before **God**, even our Father, at the coming of our Lord **Jesus Christ** with all his saints.

**1Thess 4:1** Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort *you* by the Lord **Jesus**, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please **God**, so ye would abound more and more.

**1Thess 4:14** For if we believe that **Jesus** died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in **Jesus** will **God** bring with him.

**1Thess 5:9** For **God** hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord **Jesus Christ**,

**1Thess 5:18** In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of **God** in **Christ Jesus** concerning you.

**1Thess 5:23** And the very **God** of peace sanctify you wholly; and *I pray God* your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**2Thess 1:1** Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians in **God** our Father and the Lord **Jesus Christ**:

**2Thess 1:2** Grace unto you, and peace, from **God** our Father and the Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**2Thess 1:8** In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not **God**, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord **Jesus Christ**:

**2Thess 1:12** That the name of our Lord **Jesus Christ** may be glorified in you, and ye in him, according to the grace of our **God** and the Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**2Thess 2:16** Now our Lord **Jesus Christ** himself, and **God**, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given *us* everlasting consolation and good hope through grace,

**1Tim 1:1** Paul, an apostle of **Jesus Christ** by the commandment of **God** our Saviour, and Lord **Jesus Christ**, *which is* our hope;

**1Tim 1:2** Unto Timothy, *my own son* in the faith: Grace, mercy, *and* peace, from **God** our Father and **Jesus Christ** our Lord.

**1Tim 2:5** For *there is* one **God**, and one mediator between **God** and men, the man **Christ Jesus**;

**1Tim 5:21** I charge *thee* before **God**, and the Lord **Jesus Christ**, and the elect angels, that thou observe these things without preferring one before another, doing nothing by partiality.

**1Tim 6:13** I give thee charge in the sight of **God**, who quickeneth all things, and *before Christ Jesus*, who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession;

**2Tim 1:1** Paul, an apostle of **Jesus Christ** by the will of **God**, according to the promise of life which is in **Christ Jesus**,

**2Tim 1:2** To Timothy, *my* dearly beloved son: Grace, mercy, *and* peace, from **God** the Father and **Christ Jesus** our Lord.

**2Tim 4:1** I charge *thee* therefore before **God**, and the Lord **Jesus Christ**, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom;

**Titus 1:1** Paul, a servant of **God**, and an apostle of **Jesus Christ**, according to the faith of **God**'s elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after **God**liness;

**Titus 1:4** To Titus, *mine* own son after the common faith: Grace, mercy, *and* peace, from **God** the Father and the Lord **Jesus Christ** our Saviour.

**Titus 2:13** Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great **God** and our Saviour **Jesus Christ**;

**Phlm 1:3** Grace to you, and peace, from **God** our Father and the Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**Heb 2:9** But we see **Jesus**, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of **God** should taste death for every man.

**Heb 4:14** Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, **Jesus the Son of God**, let us hold fast *our* profession.

**Heb 12:2** Looking unto **Jesus** the author and finisher of *our* faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of **God**.

**Heb 13:20** Now the **God** of peace, **that brought again from the dead** our Lord **Jesus**, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,

**Jas 1:1** James, a servant of **God** and of the Lord **Jesus Christ**, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad, greeting.

**1Pet 1:2** Elect according to the foreknowledge of **God** the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of **Jesus Christ**: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied.

**1Pet 1:3** Blessed *be* the **God** and Father of our Lord **Jesus Christ**, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of **Jesus Christ** from the dead,

**1Pet 2:5** Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to **God** by **Jesus Christ**.

**1Pet 3:21** The like figure whereunto *even* baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward **God**;) by the resurrection of **Jesus Christ**:

**1Pet 4:11** If any man speak, *let him speak* as the oracles of **God**; if any man minister, *let him do it* as of the ability which **God** giveth: that **God** in all things may be glorified through **Jesus Christ**, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

**1Pet 5:10** But the **God** of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by **Christ Jesus**, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle *you*.

**2Pet 1:1** Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of **Jesus Christ**, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of **God** and our Saviour **Jesus Christ**:

**2Pet 1:2** Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of **God**, and of **Jesus** our Lord,

**1John 4:2** Hereby know ye the Spirit of **God**: Every spirit that confesseth that **Jesus Christ** is come in the flesh is of **God**:

**1John 4:3** And every spirit that confesseth not that **Jesus Christ** is come in the flesh is not of **God**: and this is that *spirit* of anti**Christ**, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

**1John 4:15** Whosoever shall confess that **Jesus** is the Son of **God**, **God** dwelleth in him, and he in **God**.

**1John 5:1** Whosoever believeth that **Jesus** is the **Christ** is born of **God**: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.

**1John 5:5** Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that **Jesus** is the Son of **God**?

**1John 5:20** And we know that the Son of **God** is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, *even* in his Son **Jesus Christ**. This is the true **God**, and eternal life.

**2John 1:3** Grace be with you, mercy, *and* peace, from **God** the Father, and from the Lord **Jesus Christ**, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.

**Jude 1:1** Jude, the servant of **Jesus Christ**, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by **God** the Father, and preserved in **Jesus Christ**, *and* called:

**Jude 1:4** For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, un**Godly** men, turning the grace of our **God** into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord **God**, and our Lord **Jesus Christ**.

**Jude 1:21** Keep yourselves in the love of **God**, looking for the mercy of our Lord **Jesus Christ** unto eternal life.

**Rev 1:1** The Revelation of **Jesus Christ**, which **God** gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified *it* by his angel unto his servant John:

**Rev 1:2** Who bare record of the word of **God**, and of the testimony of **Jesus Christ**, and of all things that he saw.

**Rev 1:9** I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of **Jesus Christ**, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of **God**, and for the testimony of **Jesus Christ**.

**Rev 12:17** And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of **God**, and have the testimony of **Jesus Christ**.

**Rev 14:12** Here is the patience of the saints: here *are* they that keep the commandments of **God**, and the faith of **Jesus**.

**Rev 19:10** And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, *See thou do it* not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of **Jesus**: worship **God**: for the testimony of **Jesus** is the spirit of prophecy.

**Rev 20:4** And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and *I saw* the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of **Jesus**, and for the word of **God**, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received *his* mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with **Christ** a thousand years.
