



In Vain Do They Worship Me

In Matthew 15:8-9 Yahusha quoted Isa 29:13 stating that men worship YHWH in vain. How do they do that? By worshiping after the doctrines and teachings of men and not by obedience to the commandments of YHWH. YHWH will not and does not alter that which He has spoken but men alter what YHWH has said and teach it as doctrine, teaching to fear YHWH by the precepts of men.

If we are NOT totally 100% committed to keep the Law of YHWH the 10 Commandments of Exodus 20 then ALL of our worship, our singing, our hope of salvation is in vain. **There is NO hope outside** of the keeping the commandments of YHWH and having the faith of His son Yahusha.

Rev 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: **here [are] they that keep the commandments of YHWH, and the faith of Yahusha.**

Matt 19:17 And he said unto him, Why call you me good? *[there is]* none good but one, *[that is]*, YHWH: but **if you will enter into life, keep the commandments.**

Matt 15:8 This people draws nigh unto me with their mouth, and honors me with *[their]* lips; but their heart is far from me.

Matt 15:9 But **in vain** they do worship me, **teaching [for] doctrines the commandments of men.**

Isa 29:13 Wherefore the Adonai said, Forasmuch as this people draw near *[me]* with their mouth, and with their lips do honor me, but have removed their heart far from me, and their fear toward me is **taught by the precept of men:**

Ps 89:34 My covenant will I not break, **nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips.**

Matt 5:18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, **one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law,** till all be fulfilled.

Exod 20:1 And **Elohaym spoke all these words, saying,**

Exod 20:2 I *[am]* YHWH your Elohaym, which have brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

Exod 20:3 You shall have no other gods before me.

Exod 20:4 You shall not make unto you any graven image, or any likeness [of any thing] that [is] in heaven above, or that [is] in the earth beneath, or that [is] in the water under the earth:

Exod 20:5 You shall not bow down yourself to them, nor serve them: for I YHWH your Elohaym [am] a jealous Elohaym, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth [generation] of them that hate me;

Exod 20:6 And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

Exod 20:7 You shall not take the name of YHWH your Elohaym in vain; for YHWH will not hold him guiltless that takes his name in vain.

Exod 20:8 Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.

Exod 20:9 Six days shall you labor, and do all your work:

Exod 20:10 But **the seventh day [is] the sabbath of YHWH your Elohaym: [in it]** you shall not do any work, you, nor your son, nor your daughter, your manservant, nor your maidservant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger that [is] within your gates:

Exod 20:11 For [in] six days YHWH made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them [is], and rested the seventh day: wherefore YHWH blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

Exod 20:12 Honor your father and your mother: that your days may be long upon the land which YHWH your Elohaym gives you.

Exod 20:13 You shall not kill.

Exod 20:14 You shall not commit adultery.

Exod 20:15 You shall not steal.

Exod 20:16 You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

Exod 20:17 You shall not covet your neighbor's house, you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that [is] your neighbor's.

Deut 5:22 These **words YHWH spoke unto all your assembly** in the mount out of the midst of the fire, of the cloud, and of the thick darkness, **with a great voice:** and **he added no more.** And **he wrote them in two tables of stone**, and delivered them unto me.

Rom 6:15 What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law of Moses, but under grace? YHWH forbid.

Rom 6:16 Know you not, that to whom you yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants you are to whom you obey; whether **of sin unto death**, or of **obedience unto righteousness?**



1John 3:4 Whosoever commits sin transgresses also the law: **for sin is the transgression of the law.**

1John 5:2 By this we know that we love the children of YHWH, **when we love YHWH, and keep his commandments.**

1John 5:3 For this is the love of YHWH, **that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.**

Rev 22:14 Blessed **[are]** they that do his commandments, **that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.**

Rev 22:15 For without **[are]** dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and **whosoever loves and makes a lie.**
