## Obedience After Redemption

Romans 3:24 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in the Messiah Yahshua:

Romans 3:25 Whom YHVH hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to **declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past**, through the forbearance of YHVH;

Romans 3:26 To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Yahshua.

Romans 3:27 Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? No: **but by the law** of faith.

The Law of Faith is the Righteousness that comes by the WORKS of that faith. When Abraham believed YHWH, by faith he did the works, believing what YHWH said was true. After we have received the grace of redemption and our PAST sins/transgressions are washed away or removed, we then must walk in the spirit of this faith, we must walk in obedience to YHWH and his commandments, we are REQUIRED to stop sinning. IN reality the whole of scripture is about walking in obedience to YHWH's commandments from the heart, not in letter, but in spirit of heart, in truth and spirit.

Leviticus 22:31 Therefore shall you keep my commandments, and do them: I am YHVH.

Leviticus 22:32 Neither shall you profane my holy name; but I will be hallowed among the children of Israel: I am YHVH which hallow you,

Leviticus 22:33 That brought you out of the land of Egypt (out of sin), to be your Elohim: I am YHVH.

Matthew 19:17 And he said unto him, Why do you call me good? there is none good but one, that is, YHVH: but if you want to enter into life, keep the commandments.

Revelation 12:17 And the dragon was angry with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of YHVH, and have the testimony of Yahshua the Messiah.

Revelation 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of YHVH, and the faith of Yahshua.

Daniel 9:4 And I prayed unto YHVH my Elohim, and made my confession, and said, O Adonai, the great and dreadful EL, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments;

Daniel 9:5 We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from your precepts and from your judgments:

Daniel 9:6 Neither have we hearkened unto your servants the prophets, which spake in your name to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, and to all the people of the land.

- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that you sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Yahshua the Messiah the righteous:
- 1 John 2:2 And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.
- 1 John 2:3 And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.
- 1 John 2:4 He that says, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
- 1 John 2:5 But whoso keeps his word, in him verily is the love of YHVH perfected: hereby know we that we are in him.
- 1 John 2:6 He that says he abides in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.
- 1 John 2:7 Brethren, I write no new commandment unto you, but an old commandment which you had from the beginning. The old commandment is the word which you have heard from the beginning.
- 1 John 2:8 Again, a new commandment I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the darkness is past, and the true light now shines.
- 1 John 2:9 He that says he is in the light, and hates his brother, is in darkness even until now.
- 1 John 3:1 Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of YHVH: therefore the world knows us not, because it knew him not.
- 1 John 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of YHVH, and it does not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.
- 1 John 3:3 And every man that has this hope in him purifies himself, even as he is pure.
- 1 John 3:4 Whosoever commits sin transgresses also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.
- 1 John 3:5 And you know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin.
- 1 John 3:6 Whosoever abides in him sins not: whosoever sins has not seen him, neither known him.

1 John 3:7 Little children, let no man deceive you: he that does righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous.

- 1 John 3:8 <u>He that commits sin is of the devil</u>; for the devil sins from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of YHVH was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.
- 1 John 3:9 Whosoever is born of YHVH does not commit sin; for his seed remains in him: and he is not allowed to sin, because he is born of YHVH.
- 1 John 3:10 In this the children of YHVH are manifested, and the children of the devil: whosoever does not do righteousness is not of YHVH, neither is he that loves not his brother.
- 1 John 3:23 And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Yahshua the Messiah, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.
- 1 John 3:24 And he that keeps his commandments dwells in him, and he in them. And hereby we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit which he has given us.
- 1 John 5:2 By this we know that we love the children of YHVH, when we love YHVH, and **keep** his commandments.
- 1 John 5:3 For this is the love of YHVH, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

Romans 7:6 But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not in the oldness of the letter.

Romans 7:7 What shall we say then? Is the law sin? YHVH forbid. No, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet.

Romans 7:8 But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, worked in me all manner of lust. For without the law sin was dead.

Romans 7:9 For I was alive without the law once: but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died.

Romans 7:10 And the commandment, which was ordained to life, I found to be unto death.

Romans 7:11 For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it slew me.

Romans 7:12 Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.

Romans 7:13 Was then that which is good made death unto me? YHVH forbid. But sin, that it might appear sin, working death in me by that which is good; that sin by the commandment might become exceeding sinful.

Romans 8:3 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, YHVH sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

Romans 8:4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Romans 8:5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

Romans 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

Romans 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against YHVH: for it is not subject to the law of

## YHVH, neither indeed can be.

Romans 8:8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please YHVH.

Hebrews 10:24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: Hebrews 10:25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Hebrews 10:26 For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth,

## there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,

Hebrews 10:27 But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries.

Hebrews 10:28 He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: Hebrews 10:29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden underfoot the Son of YHVH, and has counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace? Hebrews 10:30 For we know him that hath said, **Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will recompense, says YHWH.** And again, YHWH shall judge his people.

Hebrews 10:31 It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of YHVH, the living ELOHIM.

Deuteronomy 32:34 Is not this laid up in store with me, and sealed up among my treasures? Deuteronomy 32:35 **To me belongeth vengeance, and recompence**; their foot shall slide in due time: for the day of their calamity is at hand, and the things that shall come upon them, make haste.

Deuteronomy 32:36 **For YHVH shall judge his people**, and repent himself for his servants, when he seeth that their power is gone, and there is none shut up, or left.

Deuteronomy 32:37 And he shall say, Where are their gods, their rock in whom they trusted, Deuteronomy 32:38 Which did eat the fat of their sacrifices, and drank the wine of their drink offerings? let them rise up and help you, and be your protection.

Deuteronomy 32:39 **See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me**: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither is there any that can deliver out of my hand.

Deuteronomy 32:40 For I lift up my hand to heaven, and say, I live forever.

Our creator is unchanging, He expects us to obey as He has from the beginning.

Yahshua did not change the commandments, he changed nothing. He fulfilled the Levitical Law which pointed to him the schoolmaster, BUT he did not change one jot or tittle of any of the law.

When tempted by the lawyer, He quoted Deut 6 and Lev 19. But He CHANGED NOTHING.

Matthew 22:35 Then one of them, which was a lawyer, asked him a question, **tempting him**, and saying,

Matthew 22:36 Master, which is the great commandment in the law?

Matthew 22:37 Yahshua said unto him, you shall love YHWH your Elohim with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.

Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear, O Israel: YHVH our Elohim is one, YHVH:

Deuteronomy 6:5 And you shalt love YHVH your Elohim with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might.

Matthew 22:38 This is the first and great commandment.

Matthew 22:39 And the second is like unto it, You shall love your neighbour as yourself. Leviticus 19:18 You shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shalt love your neighbour as yourself: I am YHVH.
