

My People

Who are the people of YHVH? That is a question that MUST be answered, but it must be answered from the scripture and NOT from the doctrines of men. We hear all over the 'christian' world men calling themselves 'children of God' or 'God's children' or 'born again' or 'God's people'. We hear the Israelites saying they are the chosen 'people of God'. But really we must ask ourselves "WHO really are the 'people of YHVH'?", "Of whom does the scripture say are the 'people of YHVH'?" The Catholics say they are, the Protestants claim they are, the AC's say they are, the Lutheran, Calvinist, Baptism, the SDAs, the list goes on and on.

The scriptures answer this question very clearly if we have the faith to believe what YHVH has told us through the prophets and through his son Yahusha by the spirit of truth. I suppose I could copy the whole Bible here but I put the evidence here so you can easily find it and will be without excuse on that great day.

When Noah came off the ark, men continued in the evil thoughts and desires of their hearts, to culminate in the building of the tower of Babel. YHVH at that time rejected ALL mankind and confounded the languages and dispersed them. Of Noah's entire house there were NO people that followed YHVH, none worshiped him. By people we are saying a 'group of people' that were following YHVH. Noah never faltered, Shem never faltered and I am sure there were other individuals that worshiped YHVH. YHVH then called out righteous Abraham to 'father' His called out chosen people, it was to be Abraham's seed that were going to be the 'people of YHVH'.

Through Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Israel) was this promise kept. Until the Exodus from Egypt men sacrificed and worshiped YHVH in any place they chose. When the children (the people) of YHVH came out of Egypt the world changed forever and was introduced to the Messiah. The only way anyone could come to YHVH after the exodus was through the Israelites, foreshadowing the coming Messiah, only through Him can mankind find salvation, only through him can mankind come to worship YHVH.

At that time YHVH set in tables of stone His law of Good and Evil, His law that defined transgression (sin) the 10 Commandments to which He added no more and He gave the foreshadow of the Messiah in the tabernacle service and sacrifices and the 7 Sabbaths and other holy days that pointed to the redemption work of the Messiah. Added to that YHVH also gave them a law of separation (clean and unclean) because of the hardness of their hearts in refusing to keep the commandments especially the 7th day Sabbath. They kept falling back into the pagan ways and so the physical law of separation was given to separate them from other people.

Israel is the 'people of YHVH', Israel is the 'my people', it was and still is only through the seed of Israel that men can find salvation. When YAHUSHA was born of a woman from the seed of Abraham of the line of David, the foreshadow of 7 Sabbaths and holy days of the redemptive work was fulfilled on the cross, the wall of separation was torn down when the veil of the temple was torn in two. The food and drinks and different washings to come to YHVH clean were done away with, there was now no need for those and Yahusha being the sacrificial lamb once and for all time removed the need for the sacrificing of animals. BUT the one thing that did not change was the reason and need of the lamb of YHVH, that was still there, the Law of YHVH was still enforce, it still defined the sin of mankind.

YHVH's people before Yahusha were ONLY the Israelites the seed of Abraham and while He wanted them to keep His 10 commandments in their hearts, they just simply would not do it and so all they did was after the carnal nature never circumcising their hearts to keep YHVH's law the 10 commandments.

Now just as after the exodus nothing changed it is still ONLY through Yahusha the seed of Abraham, through Jacob (Israel) YHVH's people that mankind can come before YHVH, but now it must be with a circumcised heart with the law of YHVH written on our hearts, this is what being born again is all about.

YHVH's people are grafted into the vine of Yahusha with a circumcised heart obeying YHVH's law of 10 commandments. Anyone breaking any of the 10 commandments is in transgression and if grafted in will be cut off and cast into the fire as chaff to be burnt up.

It is a false statement to claim to be a child of YHVH and to not keep His commandments including the 7th Day Sabbath.

The people YHVH calls 'my people' are those that repent, turn from their transgression of the law (10 Cs) and come to Yahusha to be washed clean in his death and resurrection.

Be not deceived by 'one verse' men's doctrines and false teaching of a denomination and men's definition of transgression (sin). YHVH's word is very clear, sin IS transgression of the law (10Cs), the ONLY way we KNOW we love is when we KEEP His commandments. The first 5 are how we love YHVH; the last 5 are how we love our neighbour.

Is your God **the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob**? If so then this God is an unchanging God, His name is YHVH, and HE has written an UNCHANGING law with His own finger, He has called out His people to guard His Sabbath. So from this day forth, will you obey Him or choose to defy Him to serve the doctrines of men? Choose righteousness today while the door of grace is still open! Do not **fall after the same example of unbelief** as our forefathers.

Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear, O Israel: YHVH our God is one YHVH:

Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love YHVH thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

Leviticus 19:18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am YHVH.

Mark 12:29 And Yeshua answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God YHVH is one Lord:

Mark 12:30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God YHVH with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.

Mark 12:31 And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

Matthew 22:40 On these two commandments **hang all the law** and the prophets.

Mark 12:26 And as touching the dead, that they rise: have ye not read in the book of Moses, how in the bush YHVH spake unto him, saying, **I am YHVH the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob?**

Mark 12:27 He is not the God of the dead, but the **God of the living: ye therefore do greatly err.**

Hebrews 4:8 For if Yeshua had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day.

Hebrews 4:9 **There remaineth therefore a Sabbath to the people of YHVH.**

Hebrews 4:10 For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as YHVH did from his.

Hebrews 4:11 **Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest,** lest any man **fall after the same example of unbelief.**

Genesis 12:1 Now YHVH had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:

Genesis 12:2 And I will make of thee a **great nation**, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:

Jubilees 12: 22 And he made an end of speaking and praying, and behold the word of YHVH was sent to him through me, saying: 'Get you up from your country, and from your kindred and from the house of your father unto a land which I will show you, and I shall **make you a great and numerous nation.**

23 And I will bless you And I will make your name great, And you shall be blessed in the earth, And in You shall all families of the earth be blessed, And I will bless them that bless you, And curse them that curse you.

Jasher 13:3 And Abram remained in the land three years, and at the expiration of three years the Lord appeared to Abram and said to him; I am the Lord who brought thee forth from Ur Casdim, and delivered thee from the hands of all thine enemies.

4. And now therefore if thou **wilt hearken to my voice and keep my commandments, my statutes and my laws**, then will I cause thy enemies to fall before thee, and I will multiply thy seed like the stars of heaven, and I will send my blessing upon all the works of thy hands, and thou shalt lack nothing.

5. Arise now, take thy wife and all belonging to thee and go to the land of Canaan and remain there, and **I will there be unto thee for a God, and I will bless thee**. And Abram rose and took his wife and all belonging to him, and he went to the land of Canaan as the Lord had told him; and Abram was fifty years old when he went from Haran.

7. And the Lord appeared to Abram when he came to the land of Canaan, and said to him, This is the land which I gave unto thee and to thy seed after thee forever, and I will make **thy seed like the stars of heaven**, and I will give unto thy seed for an inheritance all the lands which thou seest.

Deuteronomy 30:5 And YHVH thy God will bring thee into the land which thy fathers possessed, and thou shalt possess it; and he will do thee good, and multiply thee above thy fathers.

Deuteronomy 30:6 And YHVH thy God will **circumcise thine heart**, and the heart of thy seed, to love YHVH thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live.

Deuteronomy 10:12 And now, **Israel**, what doth YHVH thy God require of thee, but to fear YHVH thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve YHVH thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul,

Deuteronomy 10:13 **To keep the commandments of YHVH**, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good?

Deuteronomy 10:14 Behold, the heaven and the heaven of heavens is YHVH's thy God, the earth also, with all that therein is.

Deuteronomy 10:15 Only YHVH had a delight in thy fathers to love them, and he chose their seed after them, even you above all people, as it is this day.

Deuteronomy 10:16 **Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart**, and be no more stiffnecked.

Deuteronomy 10:17 For YHVH your God is God of gods, and Lord of lords, a great God, a mighty, and a terrible, which regardeth not persons, nor taketh reward:

Deuteronomy 10:18 He doth execute the judgment of the fatherless and widow, and loveth the stranger, in giving him food and raiment.

Deuteronomy 10:19 Love ye therefore the stranger: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

Deuteronomy 10:20 **Thou shalt fear YHVH thy God; him shalt thou serve, and to him shalt thou cleave, and swear by his name.**

Exodus 3:7 And YHVH said, I have surely seen the affliction of **my people** which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows;

Exodus 3:10 Come now therefore, and I will send thee unto Pharaoh, that thou mayest bring forth **my people** the children of Israel out of Egypt.

Exodus 7:16 And thou shalt say unto him, YHVH God of the Hebrews hath sent me unto thee, saying, Let **my people** go, that they may serve me in the wilderness: and, behold, hitherto thou wouldest not hear.

Exodus 16:31 And the **house of Israel** called the name thereof Manna: and it was like coriander seed, white; and the taste of it was like wafers made with honey.

Exodus 40:38 For the cloud of YHVH was upon the tabernacle by day, and fire was on it by night, in the sight of all the **house of Israel**, throughout all their journeys.

Leviticus 26:12 And I will walk among you, and will be your God, and ye shall be **my people**.

Jubilees 1:22 And YAHWEH said to Mosheh: 'I know their contrariness and their thoughts and their stiffneckedness, and they will not be obedient till they confess their own sin and the sin of their fathers.

23 And after this they will turn to Me in all uprightness and with all their heart and with all their soul, and I will circumcise the foreskin of their heart and the foreskin of the heart of their seed, and I will create in them a kodesh spirit, and I will cleanse them so that they shall not turn away from Me from that day unto eternity.

24 And their souls will cleave to Me and to all My commandments, and they will fulfill My commandments, and I will be their ABBA (Father) and they shall be **My children**.

Jubilees 2:19 And He said to us: 'Behold, I will separate unto Myself a people from among all the peoples, and these shall keep the Shabbat day, and I will sanctify them unto Myself as **My people**, and will bless them; as I have sanctified the Shabbat day and do

sanctify it unto Myself, even so will I bless them, and they shall be **My people** and I will be their Sovereign Ruler.

20 And I have chosen the seed of Yacob from amongst all that I have seen, and have written him down as My first-born son, and have sanctified him unto Myself forever and ever; and I will teach them the Shabbat day, that they may keep Shabbat thereon from all work.'

Deuteronomy 31:11 When **all Israel** is come to appear before YHVH thy God in the place which he shall choose, thou shalt read this law before all Israel in their hearing.

Deuteronomy 31:12 Gather **the people** together, men, and women, and children, and **thy stranger** that is within thy gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear YHVH your God, and observe to do all the words of this law:

Deuteronomy 30:6 And **YHVH thy God will circumcise thine heart**, and the heart of thy seed, to love YHVH thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live.

Joshua 21:45 There failed not ought of any good thing which YHVH had spoken unto the **house of Israel**; all came to pass.

2 Samuel 3:18 Now then do it: for YHVH hath spoken of David, saying, By the hand of my servant David I will save **my people** Israel out of the hand of the Philistines, and out of the hand of all their enemies.

2 Samuel 7:8 Now therefore so shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith YHVH of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, from following the sheep, to be ruler over **my people**, over Israel:

2 Samuel 7:9 And I was with thee whithersoever thou wentest, and have cut off all thine enemies out of thy sight, and have made thee a great name, like unto the name of the great men that are in the earth.

2 Samuel 7:10 Moreover I will appoint a place for **my people** Israel, and will plant them, that they may dwell in a place of their own, and move no more; neither shall the children of wickedness afflict them any more, as beforetime,

2 Samuel 7:11 And as since the time that I commanded judges to be over **my people** Israel, and have caused thee to rest from all thine enemies. Also YHVH telleth thee that he will make thee an house.

Psalms 78:1 Give ear, O **my people**, to my law: incline your ears to the words of my mouth.

Psalms 81:8 Hear, O **my people**, and I will testify unto thee: O Israel, if thou wilt hearken unto me;

Psalms 81:10 I am YHVH thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt: open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it.

Psalms 81:11 But **my people** would not hearken to my voice; and Israel would none of me.

Psalms 81:12 So I gave them up unto their own hearts' lust: and they walked in their own counsels.

Psalms 81:13 Oh that **my people** had hearkened unto me, and Israel had walked in my ways!

Proverbs 29:18 Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he.

Isaiah 30:9 That this is a **rebellious people**, **lying children**, children **that will not hear the law of YHVH**:

Isaiah 51:2 Look unto Abraham your father, and unto Sarah that bare you: **for I called him alone**, and blessed him, and increased him.

Isaiah 51:3 For YHVH shall comfort Zion: he will comfort all her waste places; and he will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of YHVH; joy and gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, and the voice of melody.

Isaiah 51:4 Hearken unto me, **my people**; and give ear unto me, O **my nation**: **for a law shall proceed from me, and I will make my judgment to rest for a light of the people**.

Isaiah 51:5 My righteousness is near; my salvation is gone forth, and mine arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait upon me, and on mine arm shall they trust.

Isaiah 49:5 And now, saith YHVH that formed me from the womb to be his servant, to bring Jacob again to him, Though Israel be not gathered, yet shall I be glorious in the eyes of YHVH, and my God shall be my strength.

Isaiah 49:6 And he said, It is a no small thing that thou shouldest be my servant to raise up the **tribes of Jacob**, and to restore the **preserved of Israel**: I will also give thee for a light to **the Gentiles**, that thou mayest be my salvation unto the end of the earth.

Isaiah 49:7 Thus saith YHVH, the Redeemer of Israel, his Holy One, to him whom man despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and

arise, princes also shall worship, because of YHVH that is faithful, the Holy One of Israel, and he shall choose thee.

Jeremiah 4:3 For thus saith YHVH to the men of Judah and Jerusalem, Break up your fallow ground, and sow not among thorns.

Jeremiah 4:4 **Circumcise yourselves** to YHVH, and take away the **foreskins of your heart**, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest my fury come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench it, because of the evil of your doings.

Jeremiah 31:31 Behold, the days come, saith YHVH, that **I will make a new covenant** with the **house of Israel**, and with the **house of Judah**:

Jeremiah 31:32 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith YHVH:

Jeremiah 31:33 But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the **house of Israel**; After those days, saith YHVH, **I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts**; and will be their God, and they shall be **my people**.

Jeremiah 31:34 And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know YHVH: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith YHVH; for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

Hebrews 8:8 For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith YHVH, when **I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah**:

Hebrews 8:9 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord.

Hebrews 8:10 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith YHVH; **I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts**: and I will be to them a God, and they shall **be to me a people**:

Hebrews 8:11 And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest.

Hebrews 8:12 For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.

Hebrews 8:13 In that he saith, A new covenant, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away.

Hosea 4:6 **My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge:** because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

Matthew 2:6 And thou Bethlehem, in the land of Juda, art not the least among the princes of Juda: for out of thee shall come a Governor, that shall rule **my people** Israel.

Acts 2:36 Therefore let all the **house of Israel** know assuredly, that YHVH hath made that same Yeshua, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and the Messiah.

Acts 7:32 Saying, I am YHVH the God of thy fathers, the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. Then Moses trembled, and durst not behold.

Acts 7:33 Then said the YHVH to him, Put off thy shoes from thy feet: for the place where thou standest is holy ground.

Acts 7:34 I have seen, I have seen the affliction of **my people** which is in Egypt, and I have heard their groaning, and am come down to deliver them. And now come, I will send thee into Egypt.

Acts 7:35 This Moses whom they refused, saying, Who made thee a ruler and a judge? the same did YHVH send to be a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the angel which appeared to him in the bush.

Romans 9:22 What if YHVH, willing to shew his wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction:

Romans 9:23 And that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory,

Romans 9:24 Even us, whom he hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?

Romans 9:25 As he saith also in Hosea 2:23, I will call them **my people**, which were not **my people**; and her beloved, which was not beloved.

Romans 9:26 And it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, Ye are not **my people**; there shall they be called the children of the living God.

Romans 9:27 Esaias also crieth concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be saved:

2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?

2 Corinthians 6:15 And what concord hath the Messiah with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?

2 Corinthians 6:16 And what agreement hath the temple of YHVH with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as YHVH hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be **my people**.

2 Corinthians 6:17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,

2 Corinthians 6:18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

Revelation 18:2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

Revelation 18:3 For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.

Revelation 18:4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, **my people**, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

Revelation 18:5 For her sins have reached unto heaven, and YHVH hath remembered her iniquities.

Revelation 12:16 And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon cast out of his mouth.

Revelation 12:17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the **remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of YHVH**, and have the testimony of Yeshua the Messiah.

Revelation 22:13 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

Revelation 22:14 **Blessed are they that do his commandments**, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

Revelation 22:15 For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie.

Revelation 22:16 I Yeshua have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star.

Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of the Messiah: for it is the power of YHVH unto **salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek**.

Romans 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of YHVH revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

Romans 1:18 For the wrath of YHVH is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness;

Romans 1:19 Because that which may be known of YHVH is manifest in them; for YHVH hath shewed it unto them.

Romans 1:20 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and divinity; so that they are without excuse:

Romans 1:21 Because that, when they knew YHVH, they glorified him not as YHVH, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

Romans 2:8 But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath,

Romans 2:9 **Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile;**

Romans 2:10 But glory, honour, and peace, to every man that worketh good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile:

Romans 2:11 **For there is no respect of persons with YHVH.**

Romans 2:12 For as many as have sinned without law shall also perish without law: and as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law;

Romans 2:13 (For not the hearers of the law are just before YHVH, but the doers of the law shall be justified.

Romans 2:28 For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither is that circumcision, which is outward in the flesh:

Romans 2:29 But **he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart**, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of YHVH.

Romans 3:1 What advantage then hath the Jew? or what profit is there of circumcision?

Romans 3:2 Much every way: chiefly, because that unto them were committed the oracles of YHVH.

Romans 3:3 For what if some did not believe? shall their unbelief make the faith of YHVH without effect?

Romans 3:4 YHVH forbid: yea, let YHVH be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged.

Romans 3:5 But if our unrighteousness commend the righteousness of YHVH, what shall we say? Is YHVH unrighteous who taketh vengeance? (I speak as a man)

Romans 10:12 For **there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek**: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him.

Galatians 3:26 For ye are all **the children of YHVH** by faith in the Messiah Yeshua.

Galatians 3:27 For as many of you as have been baptized into the Messiah have put on the Messiah.

Galatians 3:28 **There is neither Jew nor Greek**, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in the Messiah Yeshua.

Galatians 3:29 And if ye be the Messiah's, then are ye **Abraham's seed**, and **heirs according to the promise**.

Colossians 3:10 And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:

Colossians 3:11 Where **there is neither Greek nor Jew**, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: but the Messiah is all, and in all.

Colossians 3:12 Put on therefore, as the elect of YHVH, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;
