



# The Ten Commandments

---

Deuteronomy 5:22 These words YHVH spoke unto all your assembly in the mount out of the midst of the fire, of the cloud, and of the thick darkness, with a great voice: **and he added no more.** And **he wrote them in two tables of stone**, and delivered them unto me.

Matthew 5:18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, **one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.**

Exodus 20:1 And the Elohim, the all supreme Elohim, spoke all these words, saying,

## 1st Command

Exodus 20:2 **I am YHVH your Elohim**, which have brought you **out of the land of Egypt (out of sin), out of the house of bondage (the bondage of your sin).**

Exodus 20:3 **You shall have no other gods (elohim) before me.**

Mark 12:29 And Yahshua answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; **The Adonai our Elohim YHVH is one Adonai:**

Mark 12:30 And you shall love the Adonai your Elohim YHVH with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength: this is the first commandment.

Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear, O Israel: **YHVH your Elohim is one, YHVH:**

Deuteronomy 6:5 **And you shalt love YHVH your Elohim with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might.**

Isaiah 44:24 This says YHVH, your redeemer, and he that formed you from the womb, **I am YHVH that maketh all things;** that stretcheth forth the heavens **alone;** that spreadeth abroad the earth **by myself;**

Ephesians 4:4 There is one body, and one Spirit, even as you are called in one hope of your calling;

Ephesians 4:5 **One Adonai (YHWH),** one faith, one baptism,

Ephesians 4:6 **One Elohim (YHWH) and Father** of all, who is above all, and through all, and in

you all.

Ephesians 4:7 But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of **the gift of the Messiah.**

## 2nd Command

Exodus 20:4 **You shall not make unto yourself any graven image of any likeness of anything** that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth:

Exodus 20:5 **You shall not bow down yourself to them, nor serve them: for I YHVH your Elohim** am a jealous Elohim, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;

1 John 5:21 Little children, **keep yourselves from idols.**

2 Corinthians 6:15 And what concord has the Messiah with Belial? or what part has he that believeth with an infidel?

2 Corinthians 6:16 And what **agreement has the temple of YHVH with idols?** for you are the temple of the living Elohim; as **YHVH hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their Elohim, and they shall be my people.**

2 Corinthians 6:17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be you separate, says the Adonai, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,

2 Corinthians 6:18 And will be a Father unto you, and you shall be my sons and daughters, says the YHWH the Almighty.

Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, **that they abstain from pollutions of idols,** and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.

Acts 7:40 Saying unto Aaron, Make us gods to go before us: for as for this Moses, which brought us out of the land of Egypt, we do not know what is become of him.

Acts 7:41 And they made a calf in those days, and offered sacrifice unto the idol, and rejoiced in the works of their own hands.

Acts 7:42 Then YHVH turned, and gave them up to worship the host of heaven; as it is written in the book of the prophets, O house of Israel, have you offered to me slain beasts and sacrifices by the space of forty years in the wilderness?

Acts 7:43 Yes, you took up the tabernacle of Moloch, and the star of your god Remphan, figures which you made to worship them: and I will carry you away beyond Babylon.



Hebrews 4:6 Seeing therefore it remaineth that some must enter therein, and they to whom it was first preached entered not in because of unbelief:

Hebrews 4:9 **There remaineth therefore a Sabbath to the people of YHVH.**

G4520 σαββατισμός **sabbatismos** (sab-ba-tiz-mos') *n.* [from a derivative of G4521]

G4521 σάββατον **sabbaton** (sab'-ba-ton) *n.* **1. the Sabbath** (i.e. Shabbath).

Hebrews 4:10 For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as YHVH did from his.

Hebrews 4:11 **Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest,** lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.

Yahshua kept the Sabbath and throughout the Acts we find 83 observances of the Sabbath Day. The Sabbath was not abrogated anywhere in the whole of the scriptures. It was changed by the Catholic Church and that can be easily proven by 5 minutes of research, by any heart that is truly seeking and wanting to follow YHWH.

## 5th Command

Exodus 20:12 **Honour your father and your mother:** that your days may be long upon the land which YHVH your Elohim giveth you.

Ephesians 6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Adonai: for this is right.

Ephesians 6:2 **Honour thy father and mother;** (which is the first commandment with promise;)

Ephesians 6:3 That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.

Colossians 3:20 Children, obey your parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Adonai.

## 6th Command

Exodus 20:13 **You shall not kill.**

1 John 3:15 Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and you know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him.

Romans 13:9 ..., **You shall not kill**

## 7th Command

Exodus 20:14 **You shall not commit adultery.**

Matthew 5:28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

Matthew 5:32 But I say unto you, That whosoever shall put away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication, causes her to commit adultery: and whosoever shall marry her that is divorced commits adultery.

Romans 13:9 For this, **You shall not commit adultery**

## 8th Command

Exodus 20:15 **You shall not steal.**

Romans 13:9.... **You shalt not steal**

## 9th Command

Exodus 20:16 **You shall not bear false witness against your neighbour.**

Romans 13:9.... **You shalt not bear false witness**

## 10th Command

Exodus 20:17 **You shall not covet** your neighbour's house, you shall not covet your neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is your neighbour's.

Romans 13:9.... **You shall not covet**

Deuteronomy 5:22 These words YHVH spake unto all your assembly in the mount out of the midst of the fire, of the cloud, and of the thick darkness, with a great voice: **and he added no more.** And **he wrote them in two tables of stone**, and delivered them unto me.

Exodus 20:18 And all the people saw the thunderings, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw it, they removed, and stood afar off.

Exodus 20:19 And they said unto Moses, Speak you with us, and we will hear: but let not Elohim speak with us, lest we die.

Exodus 20:20 And Moses said unto the people, Fear not: for the Elohim is come to prove you, and that his fear may be before your faces, that you sin not.

Exodus 20:21 And the people stood afar off, and Moses drew near unto the thick darkness where Elohim was.

Exodus 20:22 And **YHVH said unto Moses**, This you shall say unto the children of Israel, **You**

**have seen that I have talked with you from heaven.**

Exodus 20:23 You shall not make of me gods (elohim) of silver, neither shall you make unto you gods (elohim) of gold.

Exodus 20:24 An altar of earth you shall make unto me, and shall sacrifice thereon your burnt offerings, and your peace offerings, your sheep, and thine oxen: in all places where I record my name I will come unto you, and I will bless you.

Exodus 20:25 And if you will make me an altar of stone, **you shall not build it of hewn stone:** for if you lift up your tool upon it, you have polluted it.

Exodus 20:26 Neither shall you go up by steps unto mine altar, that your nakedness be not discovered thereon.

Deuteronomy 4:2 **You shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall you diminish anything from it,** that you may keep the commandments of YHVH your God which I command you.

Deuteronomy 4:5 Behold, I have taught you statutes and judgments, even as YHVH my God commanded me, that you should do so in the land whither you go to possess it.

Deuteronomy 4:6 Keep therefore and do them; **for this is your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the nations,** which shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people.

Deuteronomy 4:7 For what nation is there so great, who has Elohim so near unto them, as YHVH our Elohim is in all things that we call upon him for?

Deuteronomy 4:8 And what nation is there so great, that has **statutes and judgments so righteous as all this law,** which I set before you this day?

Deuteronomy 4:10 Specially the day that you stood before YHVH your Elohim in Horeb, when YHVH said unto me, **Gather me the people together, and I will make them hear my words, that they may learn to fear me all the days that they shall live upon the earth, and that they may teach their children.**

Deuteronomy 4:11 And you came near and stood under the mountain; and the mountain burned with fire unto the midst of heaven, with darkness, clouds, and thick darkness.

Deuteronomy 4:12 And YHVH spake unto you out of the midst of the fire: you heard the voice of the words, but saw no similitude; only you heard a voice.

Deuteronomy 4:13 And he declared unto you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, **even ten commandments; and he wrote them upon two tables of stone.**

Deuteronomy 4:14 And YHVH commanded me at that time to teach you statutes and

judgments, that you might do them in the land when you go over to possess it.

Deuteronomy 4:15 Take you therefore good heed unto yourselves; for you saw no manner of similitude on the day that YHVH spake unto you in Horeb out of the midst of the fire:

Deuteronomy 4:16 Lest you corrupt yourselves, and make you a graven image, the similitude of any figure, the likeness of male or female,

Deuteronomy 4:17 The likeness of any beast that is on the earth, the likeness of any winged fowl that flieth in the air,

James 1:25 But whoever looks into the **perfect law of liberty**, and continues in it, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

James 2:8 If you fulfil the **royal law** according to the scripture, You shall love your neighbour as yourself, you do well:

James 2:9 But if you have respect to persons, you commit sin, and are convinced of the law as transgressors.

James 2:10 For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all.

James 2:11 For he that said, **Do not commit adultery**, said also, **Do not kill**. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law.

James 2:12 **So speak, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty.**

Romans 13:8 Owe no man anything, but to love one another: **for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.**

Romans 13:9 For this, You shall not commit adultery, You shall not kill, You shall not steal, You shall not bear false witness, You shall not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, You shall love your neighbour as yourself.

Romans 13:10 Love works no ill to his neighbour: therefore **love is the fulfilling of the law.**

1 John 5:2 By this **we know** that we love the children of YHVH, when we love YHVH, and **keep his commandments.**

1 John 5:3 For this is the love of YHVH, that **we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.**
