Looking for that blessed hope and appearing of the glorious **of the great God and Saviour** our Christ Jesus.

OR

Looking for that blessed hope and appearing of the glory, **of the great God and Saviour of us**, Christ Jesus.

HCSB puts it this way Titus 2:13 while we wait for the blessed hope and appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Our ultimate 'Saviour' is YHWH, the Great and Mighty El as we can see in Isa. In these verses there is no Aleph/Tav, only YHWH.

YHWH saves us, has reconciled us to Himself by His lamb, His son Yeshua which means 'salvation'. Yes Yeshua is there in the Scriptures, he was working with his Father then just as he is now. Only thing that changed was he came here as a man and died to redeem us to YHWH AND of course to himself. Why to himself, He is the heir of ALL things, which is mankind, US.

The preponderance of evidence is set before you. This word 'God' below is the same θεοῦ "of-a-Deity," used in Titus 2:13 and NOT ONCE in these 37 verses of salutation does Paul, John, Peter, Jude EVER, EVER refer to Yeshua as θεοῦ "of-a-Deity," This 8th grade language study and comparison is proof positive in and of itself that Paul would NEVER, EVER refer to Yeshua as God in Titus 2:13 as it does not line up with any other passages.
