

Yahusha

Born of YHWH

Luke 1:30 And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for you have found favor with יהוה YHWH.

Luke 1:31 And, behold, you shalt conceive in your womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name Yahusha.

Luke 1:32 He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and יהוה The Elohim shall give unto him the throne of his father David:

Luke 1:33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob forever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.

Luke 1:34 Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing I know not a man?

Luke 1:35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Spirit shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of יהוה.

Did Yahusha exist before the foundation of this world?

Rev 3:14 And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things says the Amen, the faithful and true witness, **the beginning of the creation of YHWH;**

Col 1:15 Who is the image of the invisible God, **the firstborn of every creature:**

Col 1:16 For on account of him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether *they be* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created on account of him, and for him:

Col 1:17 And **he is before all things**, and by him all things consist.

Phil 2:6 Who, **being in the form of God**, thought it not to be equal with God:

Phil 2:7 But made himself of no reputation, and **took upon him the form of a servant**, and **was made in the likeness of men:**

Phil 2:8 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

John 17:5 And now, O Father, glorify you me with thine own self with **the glory which I had with thee before the world was.**

Enoch 46:1 There I beheld the Ancient of days, whose head was like white wool, and with him another, whose countenance resembled that of man. His countenance was full of grace, like *that of one of the holy angels*. Then I inquired of one of the angels, who went with me, and who showed me every secret thing, **concerning this Son of man**; who he was; whence he was and why he accompanied the Ancient of days.

2 He answered and said to me, **This is the Son of man, to whom righteousness belongs**; with whom righteousness has dwelt; and who will reveal all the treasures of that which is concealed: for the **Lord of spirits has chosen him**; and his portion has surpassed all before the Lord of spirits in everlasting uprightness.

3 This Son of man, whom you behold, shall raise up kings and the mighty from their dwelling places, and the powerful from their thrones; shall loosen the bridles of the powerful, and break in pieces the teeth of sinners.

4 He shall hurl kings from their thrones and their dominions; because they will not exalt and praise him, nor humble themselves *before him*, by whom their kingdoms were granted to them. The countenance likewise of the mighty shall He cast down, filling them with confusion. Darkness shall be their habitation, and worms shall be their bed; nor from *that* their bed shall they hope to be again raised, because they exalted not the name of the Lord of spirits.

5 They shall condemn the stars of heaven, shall lift up their hands against the Most High, shall tread upon and inhabit the earth, exhibiting all their acts of iniquity, even their works of iniquity. Their strength shall be in their riches, and their faith in the gods whom they have formed with their own hands. They shall deny the name of the Lord of spirits, and shall expel him from the temples, in which they assemble;

6 And *with him* the faithful, who suffer in the name of the Lord of spirits.

Heb 1:1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spoke in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,

Heb 1:2 Has in these last days spoken unto us **by his Son**, whom he has appointed heir of all things, **by whom also he made the ages**;

Heb 1:3 Who being the brightness of *his* glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

Heb 1:4 Being made so much better than the angels, as he has by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they.

The only conclusion one can come to from the Bible is Yahusha did indeed exist before the foundation of the earth and before all things.

Savior, Salvation

Yahusha literally means salvation in Hebrew. The OT is about the salvation of YHWH for this fallen world.

H3444 יְשׁוּעָה **yshuw`ah** (yesh-oo'-aw) *n-f.*

1. **something saved.**
2. (*abstractly*) **the act or instance of saving or rescuing a soul.**

YHWH has clearly stated that HE (YHWH) is our savior our salvation

Ps 106:21 They forgot YHWH their savior, which had done great things in Egypt;

Isa 43:3 For I *am* **YHWH your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior**: I gave Egypt for your ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for thee.

Isa 45:15 Verily you *are* a God that hides thyself,

Isa 45:17 *But* **Israel shall be saved in YHWH with an everlasting salvation**: ye shall not be ashamed nor confounded world without end.

Isa 45:21 Tell ye, and bring *them* near; yea, let them take counsel together: who has declared this from ancient time? *who* has told it from that time? **have not I, YHWH?** and *there is* no God else beside me; a **just God and a Savior**; *there is* none beside me.

Titus 2:10 Not purloining, but shewing all good fidelity; that they may adorn the doctrine of **YHWH our Savior** in all things.

How then is Yahusha called the savior?

1John 4:14 And we have seen and do testify that the **Father sent the Son to be the Savior of the world.**

Yahusha is our savior in the sense that YHWH was reconciling the world to Himself through YAHUSHA the Lamb of YHWH. Yahusha did this willingly making him our savior also. The word 'savior' does not mean GOD. There are many saviors in this world, but there is only ONE way of salvation and that is by Yahusha. So both are our saviors, but the one that ultimately is saving us is YHWH, Yahusha's God, our God, Yahusha's Father and our Father.

Luke 22:42 Saying, Father, if you be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless **not my will, but thine, be done.**

2Cor 5:18 And all things *are* of YHWH, who has reconciled us to himself by Yahusha the Messiah, and has given to us the ministry of reconciliation;

2Cor 5:19 To wit, that YHWH was in the Messiah (**ref Matt 3:16** *And Yahusha, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw **the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:***) , reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and has committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

John 1:29 The next day John sees Jesus coming unto him, and says, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

John 1:36 And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he says, Behold the Lamb of God!

2Cor 11:31 YHWH, **the God and Father of our Master Yahusha** the Messiah, which is blessed for evermore, knows that I lie not.

Eph 1:3 Blessed be YHWH **the God and Father of our Master Yahusha** the Messiah, who has blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in the Messiah:

1Pet 1:3 Blessed be YHWH **the God and Father of our Master Yahusha** the Messiah, which according to his abundant mercy has begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Yahusha the Messiah from the dead,

Eph 4:4 There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;

Eph 4:5 One Lord (Yahusha), one faith, one baptism,

Eph 4:6 One God and Father (YHWH) of all, **who is above all, and through all, and in you all.**

Eph 4:7 But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of the Messiah.

1John 5:5 Who is he that overcomes the world? **He that believeth that Yahusha is the Son of YHWH!!!!!!**


Rev 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, **Now is come salvation**, and strength, and **the kingdom of our God, and the power of his the Messiah:** for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before YHWH day and night.

First and the last

Rev 1:5 And from **Yahusha the Messiah**, who is the faithful witness, and **the first begotten of the dead**, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

Rev 1:6 And has made us kings and priests unto YHWH his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Rev 1:8 I (YHWH) am Alpha and Omega, **the beginning and the ending**, says the Lord YHWH, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

Rev 1:11 Saying, ~~I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last:~~ and, What you see, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.

Rev 1:17 And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, **Fear not; I am Yahusha the first and the last:**

Rev 1:18 **I am he that lives, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore,** Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

Rev 2:7 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says unto the churches; **To him that overcomes will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of YHWH.**

Rev 2:8 And unto the angel of the church in Smyrna write; These things says **the first and the last, which was dead, and is alive;**

Rev 2:11 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says unto the churches; **He that overcomes shall not be hurt of the second death.**

Rev 2:17 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says unto the churches; To him that overcomes will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and **will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knows saving he that receives it.**

Rev 2:18 And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things says the Son of YHWH, who has his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet are like fine brass;

Rev 2:26 And he that overcomes, and keeps my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

Rev 2:27 And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.

Rev 2:28 And I will give him the morning star.

Rev 2:29 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says unto the churches.

Rev 3:1 And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; **These things says he that has the seven Spirits of YHWH, and the seven stars;** I know your works, that you have a name that you live, and are dead.

Rev 3:7 And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things says he that is holy, he that is true, he that has the key of David, he that opens, and no man shuts; and shuts, and no man opens;

Rev 3:12 Him that overcomes will I make a pillar in the temple of **YHWH, my God**, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of **YHWH, my God**, and the name of the city of **YHWH, my God**, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from **YHWH, my God**: and I will write upon him my new name.

Rev 3:14 And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; **These things says the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of YHWH;**

Rev 3:21 To him that overcomes **will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.**

Rev 3:22 **He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says unto the churches.**

Rev 5:5 And one of the elders says unto me, Weep not: behold, the **Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David**, has prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

Rev 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, **stood a Lamb as it had been slain**, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the **seven Spirits of YHWH** sent forth into all the earth.

Rev 5:12 Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory, and blessing.

Rev 5:13 And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honor, and glory, and power, be unto him that sits upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.

Rev 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called **Faithful and True**, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

Rev 19:12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

Rev 19:13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and **his name is called The Word of YHWH.**

Rev 19:14 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

Rev 19:15 And out of his mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty YHWH.

Rev 19:16 And he has on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

Rev 21:3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of YHWH is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and YHWH himself shall be with them, and be their God.

Rev 21:4 And YHWH shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

Rev 21:5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I (YHWH) make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful.

Rev 21:6 And he said unto me, It is done. **I (YHWH) am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end.** I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely.

Rev 21:7 He that overcomes shall inherit all things; and I (YHWH) will be his God, and he shall be my son.

Rev 22:12 And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

Rev 22:13 **I (YHWH) am Aleph and Tav, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.**

Rev 22:14 Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

Rev 22:16 I Yahusha have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star.

Col 1:18 And he is the head of the body, the church: **who is the beginning**, the **firstborn from the dead**; that in all *things* he might have the preeminence.

1Cor 15:27 For he has put all things under his feet. But when he says, all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him.

1Cor 15:28 And when all things shall be subdued unto him, **then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that YHWH may be all in all.**

YHWH is **the beginning and the ending**, which is, and which was, and which is to come, **the Almighty**.

Yahusha is **the first and the last, which was dead, and is alive; the beginning and the end, firstborn of the dead.**

Conclusion:

Yahusha:

1. Beginning of Creation - FIRST
2. First born creature
3. All thing created on account of him
4. Son of YHWH
5. Lamb of YHWH for our sins – BEGINNING of Salvation
6. First from the dead
7. Coming KING OF KINGS, LORD OF LORDS
8. Subject unto YHWH
9. Lays all thing at YHWH's feet – LAST , ENDING of Salvation

It is impossible to construe a triune GOD for the scriptures, Yahusha is the SON OF YHWH.
