Conversion - from wickedness to righteous

Psalms 19:7 The <u>law of YHWH</u> is perfect, <u>converting</u> the soul: the testimony of YHWH is sure, <u>making wise the simple</u>.

- 8 The statutes of YHWH are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of YHWH is pure, enlightening the eyes.

- Proverbs 3:1 My son, forget not my <u>law</u>; but let thine <u>heart</u> keep my commandments:
- Isaiah 51:7 Hearken unto me, **ye that know righteousness**, the **people in whose**heart is my law; fear ye not the reproach of men, neither be ye afraid of their revilings.
- Jeremiah 31:33 But this *shall be* the covenant that I will make with the **house of Israel**; After those days, saith YHWH, I will put my <u>law</u> in their inward parts, and <u>write</u> it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.
- those days, saith YHWH; I will **put my laws** into their mind, **and** write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:
- Hebrews 10: 14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever **them that are sanctified**.
- 15 Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before,
- This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;
- 17 And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.
- 18 Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin.
- Deuteronomy 10:16 <u>Circumcise</u> therefore the foreskin of your <u>heart</u>, and be no more stiffnecked.
- Deuteronomy 30:6 And YHWH thy God will <u>circumcise</u> thine <u>heart</u>, and the <u>heart</u> of thy seed, to love YHWH thy God with all thine <u>heart</u>, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live.
- Jeremiah 4:4 <u>Circumcise</u> yourselves to YHWH, and take away the foreskins of your <u>heart</u>, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest my fury come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench *it*, because of the evil of your doings.
- Romans 2:29 But <u>he is a Jew</u>, which is one inwardly; and <u>circumcision</u> is that of the <u>heart</u>, in the spirit, *and* not in the letter; whose praise *is* not of men, but of YHWH.

Matthew 19:17 And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, YHWH: but

if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.

Revelation 22:14 Blessed are they that **do his commandments**, that they may **have** right to the tree of life, **and** may enter in through the gates into the city.

Revelation 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of YHWH, and the faith of Yeshua.

1 John 3:7 Little children, <u>let no man deceive</u> you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous.

- 8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of YHWH was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.
- 9 Whosoever **is born** of YHWH **doth not commit <u>sin</u>**; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of YHWH.
- Romans 7: 7 What shall we say then? *Is* the law sin? YHWH forbid. Nay, **I had not known sin**, **but by the law**: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet.
- 8 But **sin**, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. For without the law sin *was* dead.
- 9 For I was alive without the law once: but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died.
- 10 And the commandment, which was ordained to life, I found to be unto death.
- 11 For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it slew me.
- 12 Wherefore the <u>law</u> is <u>holy</u>, and the commandment <u>holy</u>, and just, and good.
- Was then that which is good made death unto me? YHWH forbid. But sin, that it might appear sin, working death in me by that which is good; that sin by the commandment might become exceeding sinful.
- 14 For we know that the **law is spiritual**: but I am carnal, sold under sin.
- Romans 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against YHWH: for it is not subject to the law of YHWH, neither indeed can be.
