



## First day worship

A Biblical day throughout the whole Bible was from sundown to sundown (Gen1) and the world and Christianity has lost sight of this real truth and thus they are in error when they say Jesus arose on the first day of the week. They make up all kinds of fables to support their sunrise services and false beliefs that Jesus arose on the first day of the week. He was already gone from the tomb when the women came in the dark of the first day of the week after the 7th Day Sabbath.

Jesus arose in the END of the 7th day Sabbath. He was crucified on Wed was put in the tomb at sundown on Wed, was 3 days and 3 nights in the grave just as he said he would be (which makes Goodfriday a lie) and arose in the end of the 7th Day Sabbath.

**Matt 28:1** In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first [*day*] of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulcher.

**Matt 28:6** He is not here: for he is risen, as he said. Come, see the place where Master lay.

**John 20:1** The first [*day*] of the week comes Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulcher, and sees the stone taken away from the sepulcher.

If you have a Jesus that was killed on Friday and came forth on Sunday morning you have a false Jesus and deny the TRUE Yahusha, the true Son of YHWH. You are saying he lied when he said he would be in the grave 3 DAYS AND 3 NIGHTS. 3 days and 3 nights is NOT hard to understand.

What happened in the first day of the week was Yahusha went to his GOD (YHWH) and our GOD (YHWH) and presented himself to HIM as the first fruits from the dead, fulfilling that festival day of the Levitical Law. If you would study the feasts then you would have understanding.

You must not have read the previous post as it clearly stated there were 2, (TWO) Laws in Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy, one spoken and written by YHWH and put INSIDE the arc of the covenant and one written by Moses in a book and put on the OUTSIDE of the arc of the covenant. Truly it is correct, IF one is wanting to keep the feast days, and sabbath days of the Levitical then YES, they are required do the WHOLE of the law of Moses which is why we do not strive to keep the feasts, and Levitical sabbaths and the things required for the keeping of them of which circumcision was a requirement. Those things are no longer required.

However, the Law of YHWH, the 10 Commandments recorded in Ex 20 and Duet 5 is a COMPLETELY separate law in and of itself and one to which YHWH added no more. Just because Moses recorded the 10 C's in the Book of the Law does NOT make them part OF the Law of Moses, no more than my stating them here makes them MY words or

part of MY own teaching. These are and will always be YHWH's spoken word and written word.

**Deut 5:22** These words YHWH spoke unto all your assembly in the mount out of the midst of the fire, of the cloud, and of the thick darkness, with a great voice: and he added no more. And he wrote them in two tables of stone, and delivered them unto me.

The Sabbath of the 10 C's is completely different from the feast days and the sabbaths of Leviticus. The sabbaths of Leviticus were for covering of sins/transgressions of the 10 C's. The 7<sup>th</sup> Day Sabbath of the Law of YHWH, the 10 C's, was to remember YHWH is the creator and we are to do as He did and cease from our labors on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the week. The 7<sup>th</sup> Day Sabbath has NOTHING to with forgiveness or covering of sin, breaking the 7<sup>th</sup> Day Sabbath IS sin and thus requires a Levitical sabbath to cover that transgression. Of course, now YHWH removes the transgression of breaking the 7<sup>th</sup> Day Sabbath as any of the other 10 C's men and women have transgressed by the sacrifice of His own Son, Yahusha.

If anyone is breaking EVEN one of the 10 C's then they ARE still in sin/transgression and will die the second death. The ONLY way to escape the second death is to repent (true back to YHWH and obey His Law, the 10C's which INCLUDES the 7<sup>th</sup> Day Sabbath) and be baptized into the death and resurrection of Yahusha the anointed. In doing so we can be born again and receive the holy spirit. BUT once we are cleaned and reborn, we are required to go and sin no more, we do HIS will by obeying HIS law the 10 C's.

Yahusha told us he would reject those that claim him and break the law. If you claim Jesus and do not KEEP the Law of YHWH or say the law is done away with then you ARE a worker of iniquity (lawless one, breaker of law). That is what the Bible says, so do you actually believe the Bible or the false doctrines of men?

**Matt 7:23** And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, you that work iniquity.

**Luke 13:27** But he shall say, I tell you, I know you not whence you are; depart from me, all [you] workers of iniquity.

Is this really what you want to hear? Are your lawless doctrines of men really worth hearing these words said to you? Repent of your transgression NOW while it is available today and turn and OBEY YHWH.
