

# SABBATH

## Sunset Friday to Sunset Saturday

Gen 2:2,3	<b>Sabbath created</b> or made the Seventh Day
Exod 16:22,23,24	Sabbath observed even before the giving of the Ten Commandments
Exod 16:28,29,30	YHWH asks 'How long will you refuse to keep my commandments' <i>Again before the Ten Commandments were given</i>
Exod 20:8-11	The 4 <sup>th</sup> Commandments states to <b>REMEMBER</b> the Sabbath <i>The Sabbath Day was not created nor instituted with the 4<sup>th</sup> commandment, but confirmed as a Holy Day and a day of rest</i>
Isaiah 58:13	Lord calls the Sabbath 'My Holy Day'
Mark 2:27	Sabbath 'was made for man' the Sabbath Day was <u>not</u> just for the Jews, but for <u>ALL</u> men
Mark 2:28	Yeshua Lord of the of the Sabbath Day. Yeshua again confirms the Sabbath Day Yeshua does NOT abolish or change it.
Mark 7:6,7,8	Teaching for doctrines the commandments of men
Matt 5:18	The Law or YHWHs Law (10C) will not pass away till...
Matt 5:19	Warning against breaking one of the least of these Commandments
Luke 4:16	Yeshua kept every Sabbath Day as was His custom, why? Because HE was obedient to the Father AND because it was HIS day of rest.. HE was Lord of the Sabbath!
Apostles kept the Sabbath Day	
Acts 13:14	1 Sabbath
Acts 13:42	1 Sabbath
Acts 13:44	1 Sabbath <i>Gentiles even asked for instruction on the Sabbath</i>
Acts 16:12, 13	1 Sabbath
Acts 17:1,2	3 Sabbaths
Acts 18:4	77 Sabbaths 1.5 years
Total	84 Sabbath Day observances recorded in Acts

Hebrews 4	3 For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.4 For he spake in a certain place of the seventh day on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works.5 And in this place again, If they shall enter into my rest.6 Seeing therefore it remaineth that some must enter therein, and they to whom it was first preached entered not in because of unbelief:
1John 3:4	4 Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.
1John 5:1-5	1 Whosoever believeth that Yeshua is the the Messiah is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him. <b>2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.</b> <b>3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.</b> 4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.5 Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Yeshua is the Son of God.
Rev 12:17	17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which <b>keep</b> the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Yeshua the Messiah.
Rev14:12	12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that <b>keep</b> the commandments of God, and the faith of Yeshua.
Rev 22:14	14 Blessed are they that <b>do</b> his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.
Eccl 3:14,15	14 I know that, whatsoever God doeth, it shall be for ever: nothing can be put to it, nor any thing taken from it: and God doeth it, that men should fear before him.15 That which hath been is now; and that which is to be hath already been; and God requireth that which is past.
