1 Peter 4:11 If any man speak, let him speak as the **oracles of YHWH**; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which YHWH gives: that YHWH in all things may be glorified through Yahusha the Messiah, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Two questions: **Why so many denominations? What is the doctrine of YHWH?**

Why so many denominations?

The reason there are so many denominations is because everyone is doing what is right in their OWN EYES. They do not follow the WHOLE council and doctrine of YHWH. They pick and choose what they want to do and ignore the rest, being willing ignorant of the complete WORD of YAH. It is the same today in the Christian world as was for Israel in Paul's time, the Christians are ignorant of Yah's righteousness and are going about to establish their own righteousness, thus we have 30,000 + christian religions/denominations around the world.

Ecclesiastes 12:13 Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter:

Fear the Elohyim, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. 2

Romans 10:1 Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to YHWH for Israel is, that they might be saved.

Romans 10:2 For I bear them record that they have a zeal of Elohim, but not according to knowledge.

Romans 10:3 For they **being ignorant of YHWH's righteousness**, and **going about to establish their own righteousness**, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of YHWH.

Romans 10:4 For the Messiah is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone that believes.

Peter was not writing to non-believers, he was writing to believers that were willing ignorant.

What is the ONE doctrine of YHWH?

The doctrines of YAH are so very simple even babies/children can understand it.

Keep YHWH's commandments/orders that is His doctrine/teaching. This is the NUMBER ONE fundamental premise of the WHOLE council of YAH, from the beginning of creation to the end of time, from the beginning of the Bible to the end of the Bible.

Once man fell to rebellion and transgression an added doctrine of YHWH came into effect 'redemption'. To be redeemed one must repent, be baptism in His son Yahusha the Messiah, receiving of the Holy Spirit. This 'redemption' process was how YHWH was redeeming us back to Himself [YHWH]. The 'grace' of YHWH towards men was to give them a chance to begin anew and to walk as originally created, He has given us the opportunity to receive a soft heart on which He could and would write His LAW in place of the heart of stone which has the law of our own eyes written in it.

This grace of redemption did not and does not abrogate/take away the very fundamental foundation that made it necessary for a redemption process/plan, which is to KEEP the COMMANDMENTS/ORDERS of YHWH.

Fear the Elohyim, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. 4

Matthew 11:29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and you shall find rest unto your souls.

Psalms 19:9 The fear of YHWH is clean, enduring forever: the judgments of YHWH are true and righteous altogether.

Romans 3:29 Is he Elohyim of the Jews only? is he not also of the Gentiles? Yes, of the Gentiles also:

Romans 3:30 seeing it is **one Elohyim,** which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith.

Romans 3:31 Do we then make void the law through faith? YHWH forbid: yea, **we establish the law.**

Ephesians 4:4 There is **one body,** and **one Spirit,** even as you are called in **one hope** of your calling;
