



The Laws

Re-looking at 2 Corinthians 3:7 But if the **ministration of death, written and engraven in stones**, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not stedfastly behold the face of Moses for the glory of his countenance; which glory was to be done away:

What was given immediately after Moses came down from the mountain the second time (Ex 34,35) ? We are wrong to lump the *'whole of Moses'* in this ministration of death. The administration of death for which Moses's face shone was the Levitical priesthood and the punishments for violating/transgressing the law of 10 Commandments and the statutes and judgements of Moses. Death was involved in every aspect of the tabernacle/temple service and yet it made nothing whole. Death was all round them (millions of animals slain), it was the **administration of condemnation**, they had to remember all their sin year after year even the sin for 15 years before had to be remembered, they were condemned, looking for that better hope. 2 Corinthians 3:9 For if the **administration of condemnation** be glory, much more does the administration of righteousness exceed in glory.

This administration of death executed judgement on transgressors of the 10 Commandments of YHWH and the statues of Moses.

This **administration was indeed written in stones**. In Joshua 8:31 we find that fact: As Moses the servant of the YHWH commanded the children of Israel, as it is written in the book of the law of Moses, **an altar of whole stones**, over which no man hath lift up any iron: and they offered thereon burnt offerings unto the YHWH, and sacrificed peace offerings.

32 **And he wrote there upon the stones a copy of the law of Moses**, which he wrote in the presence of the children of Israel.

Deut 27:1 And Moses with the elders of Israel commanded the people, saying, Keep all the commandments which I command you this day.

2 And it shall be on the day when you shall pass over Jordan unto the land which YHWH your Elohaym gives you, that **you shall set you up great stones, and plaister them with plaister:**

3 **And you shall write upon them all the words of this law**, when you are passed over, that you may go in unto the land which YHWH your Elohaym gives you, a land that floweth with milk and honey; as YHWH the Elohaym of your fathers has promised you.

4 Therefore it shall be **when you be gone over Jordan, [that] you shall set up these stones**, which I command you this day, in mount Ebal, and **you shall plaister them with plaister.**

5 And there shall you build an altar unto YHWH your Elohaym, an altar of stones: you shall not lift up **[any] iron [tool]** upon them.

6 You shall build the altar of YHWH your Elohaym of whole stones: and you shall offer burnt offerings thereon unto YHWH your Elohaym:



7 And you shall offer peace offerings, and shall eat there, and rejoice before YHWH your Elohaym.

8 And you shall write upon the stones all the words of this law very plainly.

In Joshua it just tells us they were written, but in 2 Cor 3:7 it expounds on that a little to let us know they were not "just" written but engraved just as the 10 commandments were written on the 2 Tablets with the finger of YHWH. However the *letter* to the Corinthians does not trump the *scripture* but it does make it very clear Paul was talking about the Book of the Law or the Law of Moses and NOT about the spoken and written Law of YHWH.

There are actually a number of laws of YHWH that are fully binding on mankind, we have the **Law of creation**, the **Law of sin and death**, the **Law of animals for food**, the **Law of not eating blood**, the **Law of YHWH**, the **Law of the Levitical Priesthood** and the **Law of separation** (603) of which the whole of these laws are recorded in the "Torah" or "Moses".

Note: The law of separation (613) do's and do not's are actually not a law unto themselves, but men have grouped the Law of YHWH and the Book of the law, the creation laws into this list, 10 of the list are from YHWH's mouth and 603 we learn from Moses.

For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little...

What **Yahusha fulfilled was the Law of the Levitical Priesthood** which was a foreshadowing, a schoolmaster of what His ministry was going to be. His life, death and resurrection fulfilled the Law of the Levitical Priesthood and removed the Law of separation (603) making all men one flesh.

Eph 2:11 Therefore remember, that you being in time past Gentiles in the flesh, **who are called Uncircumcision by those that are called the Circumcision** in the flesh made by hands;

12 That at the time you were without the Messiah, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without the Elohaym in the world:

13 But now in the Messiah Yahusha you who were afar off are made close by the blood of the Messiah.

14 For he is our peace, **who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of partition between us;**

15 Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of two men, one new man, so making peace;

The Law of YHWH (10Cs) was never referred to as the Law of condemnation, the law of death. It was always perfect, good, light, a law unto life, now as Paul says he found it to be death to him but that it was not the law but **it was his sin** that made it death unto him and that death was enforced but the **law of sin and death**. Romans 7:10



And the commandment, **which was ordained to life**, I found to be unto death. 11 **For sin**, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it slew me. 12 **Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.**

Matthew 19:17 And he said unto him, Why do you call me good? there is none good but one, that is, YHWH: but if **you want to enter into life, keep the commandments.**

Proverbs 6:23 For the commandment is a lamp; and the law is light; and reproofs of instruction are the way of life:

Psalms 19:7 The **law of the YHWH is perfect**, converting the soul: the testimony of the YHWH is sure, making wise the simple.

Yahusha's life and sacrifice defeated death and paid the price for mankind to be freed from the Law of sin and death.

(1Cor 15:54) So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, **Death is swallowed up in victory.**

(Rom 6:23) For the wages of sin [is] death; but the gift of YHWH [is] eternal life through Yahusha the Messiah our Adonai.

(Rom 6:9) Knowing that the Messiah being raised from the dead dies no more; **death has no more dominion over him.**

(2Tim 1:10) But is now made manifest by the appearing of our **Savior Yahusha the Messiah, who has abolished death**, and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:

The Laws

Law of Creation

Each animal after its own kind, each plant after its own kind, man and woman one each in marriage never to be divided, divorce and adultery forbidden, herbs given for food, 7th Day Sabbath blessed and sanctified, making it UNCHANGEABLE till the end of time. Gen 1:31 And Elohaym saw everything that he had made, and, behold, it was very good.

The Law of sin/transgression/dysfunctionality/missing the mark and the second death of the soul was established. Gen 2:17 and from the tree of the discernment of function and dysfunction you will not eat from him given that **in the day you eat from him a dying you will die,**

Law of animal for food

Gen 9:2-3 every beast of the earth, and upon every fowl of the air, upon all that moves/creeps upon the earth, and upon all the fish of the sea; **every moving thing that lives shall be food** for you; even as the green herb have I given you all things.

Law of not eating blood

Gen 9:4-5 But flesh with the life thereof, which is **the blood thereof, shall you not**



eat. And surely your blood of your lives will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I require the life of man.

Leviticus 7:26-27 Moreover **you shall eat no manner of blood**, whether it be of fowl or of beast, in any of your dwellings. 27 Whoever **eats any manner of blood**, even that soul shall be cut off from his people.

Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, **that they abstain** from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, **and from things strangled, and from blood.**

Acts 15:29 **That you abstain** from food offered to idols, and **from blood, and from things strangled**, and from fornication: from which if you keep yourselves, you will do well. Fare you well.

Law of YHWH

This law spoken by Yahweh our Elohaym in Ex 20 defining good and evil was known from the fall at the beginning of creation when man gained the knowledge of good and evil. The definition of sin in our very New Testaments is breaking the Law. 1 John 3:4 Whosoever commits sin transgresses also the law: for **sin is the transgression of the law.**

These four laws are unchangeable, cannot be transcended, Eccl 3:14 I know that, whatsoever Elohaym does, it shall be forever: nothing can be put to it, nor any thing taken from it: and Elohaym does it, that men should fear before him. 15 That which has been is now; and that which is to be, has already been; and Elohaym requires that which is past.

When the children of Abraham, (unto whom YHWH promised the "seed" that should come), were delivered from Egypt the "gospel" began to be "preached" unto them. Heb 4:1 Let us therefore fear, unless, a promise being left us of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it. 2 **For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them:** but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.

Out of Egypt this "gospel" came in the way of the Law of the Levitical Priesthood.

Law of the Levitical Priesthood

2 Cor 3:7-9 ministration of death, ministration of condemnation, could not bring life, a schoolmaster. Galatians 3:24 "Therefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto the Messiah, that we might be justified by faith. 25 But after faith has come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster." All meant to be passing away never intended to be permanent. Schools are meant to be passed through and then done. Hebrews 8:13 "In that he says, A new covenant, he has made the first old. Now that which decays and waxes old is ready to vanish away." The Messiah fulfilled this with his life and minster and with our new convent this Law of the Levitical Priesthood decayed and waxed old and has vanished away. Hebrews 7: 7 For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second. 11 If therefore perfection were



by the Levitical priesthood, (for under it the people received the law,) what further need was there that another priest should rise after the order of Melchisedec, and not be called after the order of Aaron? Hebrews 7:17 For he testifies, You are a priest forever after the order of Melchisedec. Hebrews 8:1 Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such a high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens; 2 A minister of the sanctuary, and of the true tabernacle, which the YHWH pitched, and not man. **A New Priesthood.**

Law of separation (603)

Ex 33:16-17 requested by Moses before going up the mountain the second time to receive the 10 commandments and granted by Yahweh.

Exodus 33:16 For how shall it be known that I and your people have found grace in your sight? is it not in that you go with us? **so shall we be separated**, I and your people, **from all the people that are upon the face of the earth.** 17 And YHWH said unto Moses, **I will do this thing also that you have spoken:** for you have found grace in my sight, and I know you by name.

Eze 20:25 Wherefore I gave them also **statutes that were not good**, and **judgments whereby they should not live;** Eze 20:26 And I polluted them in their own gifts, in that they caused to pass through the fire all that opens the womb, that I might make them desolate, to the end that they might know that I am YHWH.

These were removed, nailed to the cross. Col 2:14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

Col 2:10 And **you are complete in him**, which is the head of all principality and power:

We are complete in Yahusha, we are clean nothing from the outside can make us unclean, we are whole. The veil is torn and we have access to the throne room of YHWH. We are all one.

Eph 2:14 For he is our peace, **who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of partition between us;**

15 Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace;
