



Never stop sinning

The Protestant Christian world teaches that we are all born sinners and that we will never be able to cease from sin/transgression. Yes, we are born again but still just sinners, born again sinners verses unborn again sinners. Even as a born-again child of YHWH we will still sin and there is nothing we can do about it, it will happen. That is the message given by 98% of the churches today. I say 98% as there are some churches that preach that you must not sin and if you do, they will expel you from the congregation sighting Paul in 1 Cor 5:9-13. The problem with those churches is that they have their own definition of sin, and all the while transgressing the Sabbath, they excommunicate according to their own men's doctrines. I for one was put out of the church of my youth because I started keeping the 7th Day Sabbath.

The doctrine of never being able to cease from sin is not a Biblical doctrine and is a man-made doctrine. There can be many speculations why this doctrine exists but I have two possible reasons I will share.

The first reason is that for the most part the church has been deceived for a very long time and that deception comes from the belief the 10 Commandments are not binding on mankind today, that we are under grace and not the Law of YHWH. The other part of this deception is men believe in a three headed God which is a false God. They are baptized into this false religion and really never are able to overcome sin and so just keep on sinning and have to make up the false doctrine of always being a sinner, because they cannot overcome.

The second reason could be that folks do not know what sin actually is, even though John makes it very clear for us that sin IS the transgression of the Law, folks just simply do not believe that, it is unbelief. They believe temptation is a sin, not knowing that having a lustful thought is NOT sin unless we entertain that thought, but if we rebuke the devil and his thought, keeping our minds clean, we have not sinned.

We are at war in our flesh, and our fighting that war as bad as it can make us feel is NOT sin. We have an enemy that is fighting us, fighting YHWH the creator and he does it by putting thoughts in our minds and evil before our eyes, it is what we do with those things that determines if it is sin, it is NOT those temping things that are sin.

We can overcome sin in the flesh and we MUST overcome sin in the flesh if we want to enter into the Kingdom of YHWH. The statement that it is IMPOSSIBLE to not sin, is so completely false, many marriages are lived without the husband or wife committing adultery, on my street I do not know of anyone that has murdered anyone, there are many that go to their graves without murdering anyone, same with stealing, bearing false witness. To say it is IMPOSSIBLE to keep the commandments or to stop sinning really is nothing more than a lie from the devil. Same as from the beginning, you shall not die the dying [second death]. We can stop sin; all we have to do is choose to do so.

When we repent [stop sinning] then we can come to Yahusha and his blood to be washed clean, be truly born again.

Conclusion

This false doctrine contradicts John in 1 John 3, Paul in Romans 3 and 6, James in James 1. There is not one single verse in the whole of the Bible that says we cannot stop sinning. There is not even a verse that remotely reflects this kind of thought, it is simply a false man made-up doctrine.
