



Revelation

Rev 22:18 For I testify unto every man that **hears the words** of the prophecy of this book, **if** any man **shall add** unto these things, **YHWH shall add unto him the plagues** that are written in this book:

Rev 22:19 And **if** any man **shall take away** from the words of the book of this prophecy, **YHWH shall take away his part out of the book of life**, and out of the holy city, and *[from]* the things which are written in this book.

It is time to take this very seriously. Our creator is NOT playing around, He is NOT receiving nor is He accepting what we believe is RIGHT in our own eyes, He is NOT accepting doctrines nor traditions of men. Time to get that very clear right now.

Yahusha has already warned us, so we are completely without any excuse at all.

Matt 7:21 Not everyone that says unto me, Lord, Lord shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but **he that does the will of my Father** which is in heaven.

Matt 7:22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord have we not prophesied in your name? and in your name have cast out devils? and in your name done many wonderful works?

Matt 7:23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, you that work iniquity [lawlessness/without law/law breakers].

Luke 13:27 But he shall say, I tell you, I know you not whence you are; depart from me, all *[you]* workers of iniquity [a deed violating law and justice, act of unrighteousness].

Rev 1:1 **The Revelation** of Yahusha the Messiah, **which YHWH gave unto him**, to show unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified *[it]* by his angel unto his servant John:

Rev 1:2 Who bare record of the word of YHWH, and of the testimony of Yahusha the Messiah, and of all things that he saw.

Rev 1:3 Blessed *[is]* he that **reads**, and they that **hear** the words of this prophecy, and are **keeping** those things which are written therein: for the time *[is]* at hand.

Concordant Literal Version CLV

Rev 1:3 Happy is he •who is **reading** and •those who are **hearing** the word of the prophecy, and who are **keeping** •that which is °written~ in it, for the era is near.

The REVELATION of Yahusha which **YHWH the ONE and ONLY ELOHAYM** gave to him, we are to **read, hear** and **do/keep** those things written therein and in doing so we will gain great understanding and wisdom.

This direct revealing from YHWH is very clear. YHWH the Elohaym/Theos is the one sitting on the throne in heaven. To change Yahusha into a 'GOD' or part of a 'GOD' changes this very word of Revelation. Where does that leave one that does such a thing according to Rev 22:18-19?

Rev 1:4 John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace *[be]* unto you, and peace, from him *which is*, and *which was*, and *which is to come*; and from the **seven Spirits** which are **before his throne**; **15** And from Yahusha the Messiah, *[who is]* the faithful witness, *[and]* the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

Rev 1:8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, says YHWH [the Theos/Elohaym], *which is*, and *which was*, and *which is to come*, the Almighty.

Yahusha is NOT one single time referenced to as THE ONE sitting on the throne of YHWH/Theos/Elohaym, only standing beside or sitting with or standing in front of the throne of YHWH/Theos/Elohaym. If one puts Yahusha on the throne, where does that leave him according to Rev 22:18-19?

Rev 4:2 And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, **a throne was set in heaven, and *[one]* sat on the throne.**

Rev 4:3 And **he that sat** was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and *[there was]* a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.

Rev 4:8 And the four beasts had each of them six wings about *[him]*; and *[they were]* full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Adonai YHWH Almighty, *which was, and is, and is to come.*

Rev 4:9 And when those beasts give glory and honor and thanks **to him that sat on the throne**, who lives for ever and ever,

Rev 4:5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and *[there were]* seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are **the seven Spirits of YHWH.**



To change the Holy [set apart] Spirit/Spirit of truth/comforter/helper into a 'GOD' or a third part of a 'GOD' changes this true word of revelation, as we can see there are seven spirits OF 'GOD' before Him. Is the 'Holy' [set apart] Spirit one of these? I would say no as it is a special *set apart spirit* given to men, these seven were sent to the seven assemblies.

To deny GOD has more than one spirit and claim the 'Holy' Spirit is GOD changes this revelation and where does that leave one doing so according to Rev 22:18-19?

Rev 3:12 Him that overcomes will I make a pillar in the temple of **my Elohaym**, and he shall go out no more: and I will write upon him the name of **my Elohaym**, and the name of the city of **my Elohaym**, *[which is]* new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from **my Elohaym**: and *[I will write upon him]* my new name.

Rev 3:14 And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things says the Amen, the faithful and true witness, **the beginning of the creation of YHWH**;

To deny that Yahusha, even in the heavens has a 'GOD' or to deny that he was the beginning of YHWH's creation, you change the words of this revelation. The scriptures are very clear YHWH is THE Elohaym [GOD], Yahusha was very clear that he has a GOD and very clear that he was GOD's son. When one changes what this revelation says where do that put him according to Rev 22:18-19?

Rev 2:7 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says unto the churches; To him that **overcomes** will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of YHWH.

Rev 2:11 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says unto the churches; He that **overcomes** shall not be hurt of the second death.

Rev 2:17 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says unto the churches; To him that **overcomes** will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knows saving he that receives *[it]*.

Rev 2:26 And he that **overcomes**, and keeps my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

Rev 3:5 He that **overcomes**, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

Rev 3:12 Him that **overcomes** will I make a pillar in the **temple of my Elohaym**, and he shall go out no more: and I will write upon him the **name of my Elohaym**, and the name of the **city of my Elohaym**, *[which is]* new Jerusalem, which comes down **out of heaven from my Elohaym**: and *[I will write upon him]* my new name.

Rev 3:21 To him that **overcomes** will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

When one believes he can transgress/sin and still enter into the Kingdom and have right to the tree of life, when they say 'Yahusha only no matter how I act' OR they say 'you can never stop the transgression meaning you cannot overcome', then you change the word of this revelation and where does that put you according to Rev 22:18-19?

Rev 12:17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which **keep the commandments of YHWH**, and have the testimony of Yahusha the Messiah.

Rev 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here [are] they **that keep the commandments of YHWH**, and the faith of Yahusha.

Rev 22:14 Blessed [are] they that **do his commandments**, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

When one says the 10 Commandments or the Commandments of YHWH [GOD] are no longer binding and call themselves *saints* or *children of God* they change this revelation, where does that put them according to Rev 22:18-19?

Rev 21:7 He that **overcomes** shall inherit all things; and I will be his Elohaym, and he shall be my son.

Rev 21:8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and **all liars**, shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

Rev 22:15 For without [are] dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and **whosoever loves and makes a lie**.

When you change the commands of GOD and make them say something they do not say, when you make Yahusha a 'GOD', when you make the *Set Apart* Spirit given to men a 'GOD' you become an idolater and a liar and idolaters and all liars and the lovers of the lie are all going into the second death lake of fire. When you twist the words of Paul to your own destruction, you are a liar. The sad part is if you remain in that deception, there is no way YHWH can get His light to shine in you because it is of a freewill that we accept and see His truth.
