

My People

Who are the people of YHWH? That is a question that MUST be answered, but it must be answered from the scripture and NOT from the doctrines of men. We hear all over the 'christian' world men calling themselves 'children of God' or 'God's children' or 'born again' or 'God's people'. We hear the Israelites saying they are the chosen 'people of God'. But really, we must ask ourselves "WHO really are the 'people of YHWH'?", "Of whom does the scripture say are the 'people of YHWH'?" The Catholics say they are, the Protestants claim they are, the AC's say they are, the Lutheran, Calvinist, Baptists, the SDAs, the list goes on and on.

The scriptures answer this question very clearly if we have the faith to believe what YHWH has told us through the prophets and through his son Yahusha by the spirit of truth. I suppose I could copy the whole Bible here but I put the evidence here so you can easily find it and will be without excuse on that great day.

When Noah came off the ark, men continued in the evil thoughts and desires of their hearts, to culminate in the building of the tower of Babel. YHWH at that time rejected ALL mankind and confounded the languages and dispersed them. Of Noah's entire house there were NO people that followed YHWH, none worshiped him. By people we are saying a 'group of people' that were following YHWH. Noah never faltered and I am sure there were other individuals that worshiped YHWH. YHWH then called out righteous Abraham to 'father' His called out chosen people, it was to be Abraham's **seed** [Yahusha] in whom were to be the 'people of YHWH'.

Through Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Israel) was this promise kept. Until the Exodus from Egypt men sacrificed and worshiped YHWH in any place they chose. When the children (the people) of YHWH came out of Egypt the world changed forever and was introduced to the <u>anointed one</u> [mashiach/messiah/christos]. The only way anyone could come to YHWH after the exodus was through the Israelites, foreshadowing the coming <u>anointed one</u> [mashiach/messiah/christos], only through Him can mankind find salvation, only through Him can mankind come to worship YHWH. The "people of YHWH" "Israel" were **ALL** who came to YHWH through Moses and the Levites, not just the **blood line** of Abraham.

At that time YHWH set in tables of stone His law of Good and Evil, functionality and dysfunctionality, His law that defined transgression (sin) the 10 Commandments to which He added no more and He gave the **foreshadow** of the <u>anointed one</u> [mashiach/messiah/christos] in the tabernacle service and sacrifices and the 7 Sabbaths and other holy days that pointed to the redemption work of the <u>anointed one</u>. Adding to that YHWH also gave them a law of separation (clean and unclean), requested by Moses, because of the hardness of their hearts in refusing to keep the commandments especially the 7th day Sabbath. They kept falling back into

the pagan ways and so the physical law of separation, requested by Moses, was given to separate them from other people.

'Israel' is the 'people of YHWH', 'Israel' is the 'my people', it was and still is only through the **seed** of Abraham that men can find salvation. When YAHUSHA was born of a woman from the **seed** of Abraham of the line of David, the foreshadowing of 7 Sabbaths and holy days of the redemptive work began to be fulfilled and culminated at the cross and resurrection, the wall of separation was torn down when the veil of the temple was torn in two. The food and drinks and different washings to come to YHWH clean were done away with, there was now no need for those temporal things as Yahusha being the sacrificial lamb once and for all time removed the need for the sacrificing of animals and those cleansings. BUT the one thing that did not change was the reason and need of the lamb of YHWH, that was still there, the Law of YHWH was still enforce, it still defined the sin of mankind.

Today, just as after the exodus, nothing changed it is still ONLY through Yahusha the **seed** of Abraham, that mankind can come before YHWH and be grafted in to become YHWH's People [Israel], but now it must be with a circumcised heart with the law of YHWH written on our hearts, this is what being born again is all about.

YHWH's people are grafted into the vine of Yahusha with a circumcised heart obeying YHWH's law of 10 commandments regardless of being of the **blood line** of Abraham or not. Anyone breaking any of the 10 commandments is in transgression and if grafted in will be cut off and cast into the fire as chaff to be burnt up.

It is a false statement to claim to be a child of YHWH and to not keep His commandments including the 7th Day Sabbath.

The people YHWH calls 'my people' are those that repent, turn from their transgression of the law (10 Cs) and come to Yahusha to be washed clean in his death and resurrection.

Be not deceived by 'one verse' men's doctrines and false teaching of a denomination and men's definition of transgression (sin). YHWH's word is very clear, **sin IS transgression of the law** (10Cs), the ONLY way we KNOW we love is when we KEEP His commandments. The first 5 are how we love YHWH; the last 5 are how we love our neighbor.

Conclusion

YHWH is **the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob**. YHWH is an unchanging God, HE has written an UNCHANGING law with His own finger, His PEOPLE obey Him with a circumcised heart. He has called out His people to guard His Sabbath. YHWH's People are those that obey, those that do not obey are cut off and will be cast into the fire. YHWH's people are not a bloodline, they are a heart line.



Will you obey Him or choose to defy Him to serve the doctrines of men? Choose righteousness today while the door of grace is still open! Do not **fall after the same example of unbelief** as our forefathers.

Gal 3:16 Now to Abraham and his **seed** were the promises made. He says not, And to seeds, as of many; but **as of one**, And **to your seed, which is the anointed**.

Gal 3:17 And this I say, [that] the covenant, that was confirmed before of YHWH in the anointed, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years **after**, cannot disannul, that it should make the promise of none effect.

Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear, O Israel: YHWH our God is one YHWH:

Deuteronomy 6:5 And you shall love YHWH your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might.

Leviticus 19:18 You shall not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: I am YHWH.

Mark 12:29 And Yahusha answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The YHWH our God is one YHWH:

Mark 12:30 And you shall love the YHWH your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength: this is the first commandment.

Mark 12:31 And the second is like, namely this, You shall love your neighbor as yourself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

Matthew 22:40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

Mark 12:26 And as touching the dead, that they rise: have you not read in the book of Moses, how in the bush YHWH spoke unto him, saying, I am YHWH the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob?

Mark 12:27 He is not the God of the dead, but the God of the living: you therefore do greatly error.

Hebrews 4:8 For if Yahusha had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day.

Hebrews 4:9 There remains therefore a Sabbath to the people of YHWH.

Hebrews 4:10 For he that is entered into his rest, he also has ceased from his own works, as YHWH did from his.

Hebrews 4:11 Let us labor therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.

Genesis 12:1 Now YHWH had said unto Abram, Get you out of your country, and from your kindred, and from your father's house, unto a land that I will shew you:

Genesis 12:2 And I will make of you a great nation [The Kingdom of YHWH], and I will bless you, and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing:

Jubilees 12: 22 And he made an end of speaking and praying, and behold the word of YHWH was sent to him through me, saying: 'Get you up from your country, and from your kindred and from the house of your father unto a land which I will show you, and I shall make you a great and numerous nation.

23 And I will bless you And I will make your name great, And you shall be blessed in the earth, And in You shall all families of the earth be blessed, And I will bless them that bless you, And curse them that curse you.

Jasher 13:3 And Abram remained in the land three years, and at the expiration of three years the YHWH appeared to Abram and said to him; I am the Elohaym who brought you forth from Ur Casdim, and delivered you from the hands of all your enemies.

- **4.** And now therefore if you **wilt hearken to my voice and keep my commandments, my statutes and my laws,** then will I cause your enemies to fall before you, and I will multiply your seed like the stars of heaven, and I will send my blessing upon all the works of your hands, and you shall lack nothing.
- 5. Arise now, take your wife and all belonging to you and go to the land of Canaan and remain there, and I will there be unto you for a God, and I will bless you. And Abram rose and took his wife and all belonging to him, and he went to the land of Canaan as the Lord had told him; and Abram was fifty years old when he went from Haran.
- **7.** And the Lord appeared to Abram when he came to the land of Canaan, and said to him, This is the land which I gave unto you and to your seed after you forever, and I will make **your seed like the stars of heaven**, and I will give unto your seed for an inheritance all the lands which you see.

Deut 30:1 And it shall come to pass, when all these things are come upon you, the blessing and the curse, which I have set before you, and you shall call [them] to mind among all the nations, whither YHWH your Elohaym has driven you,

Deut 30:2 And shall return unto YHWH your Elohaym, and shall obey his voice according to all that I command you this day, you and your children, with all your heart, and with all your soul;

Deut 30:3 That then YHWH your Elohaym will turn your captivity, and have compassion upon you, and will return and gather you from all the nations, whither YHWH your Elohaym has scattered you.

Deut 30:4 If [any] of your be driven out unto the outmost [parts] of heaven, from thence will YHWH your Elohaym gather you, and from thence will he fetch you:



Deut 30:5 And YHWH your God will bring you into the land which your fathers possessed, and you shall possess it; and he will do you good, and multiply you above your fathers.

Deut 30:6 And YHWH your God will **circumcise your heart**, and the heart of your seed, to love YHWH your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, that you mayest live.

Deuteronomy 10:12 And now, **Israel**, what does YHWH your God require of you, but to fear YHWH your God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve YHWH your God with all your heart and with all your soul,

Deuteronomy 10:13 To keep the commandments of YHWH, and his statutes, which I command you this day for your good?

Deuteronomy 10:14 Behold, the heaven and the heaven of heavens is YHWH's your God, the earth also, with all that therein is.

Deuteronomy 10:15 Only YHWH had a delight in your fathers to love them, and he chose their seed after them, even you above all people, as it is this day.

Deuteronomy 10:16 Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart, and be no more stiff-necked.

Deuteronomy 10:17 For YHWH your God is God of gods, and Lord of lords, a great God, a mighty, and a terrible, which regards not persons, nor takes reward:

Deuteronomy 10:18 He does execute the judgment of the fatherless and widow, and loveth the stranger, in giving him food and raiment.

Deuteronomy 10:19 Love therefore the stranger: for you were strangers in the land of Egypt.

Deuteronomy 10:20 You shall fear YHWH your God; him shall you serve, and to him shall you cleave, and swear by his name.

Exodus 3:7 And YHWH said, I have surely seen the affliction of **my people** which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows;

Exodus 3:10 Come now therefore, and I will send you unto Pharaoh, that you may bring forth **my people** the children of Israel out of Egypt.

Exodus 7:16 And you shall say unto him, YHWH, God of the Hebrews has sent me unto you, saying, Let **my people** go, that they may serve me in the wilderness: and, behold, hitherto you would not hear.

Exodus 16:31 And the **house of Israel** called the name thereof Manna: and it was like coriander seed, white; and the taste of it was like wafers made with honey.

Exodus 40:38 For the cloud of YHWH was upon the tabernacle by day, and fire was on it by night, in the sight of all the **house of Israel**, throughout all their journeys.

Leviticus 26:12 And I will walk among you, and will be your God, and you shall be **my people**.

Jubilees 1:22 And YHWH said to Mosheh: 'I know their contrariness and their thoughts and their stiff-neckedness, and they will not be obedient till they confess their own sin and the sin of their fathers.

23 And after this they will turn to Me in all uprightness and with all their heart and with all their soul, and I will circumcise the foreskin of their heart and the foreskin of the heart of their seed, and I will create in them a kodesh spirit, and I will cleanse them so that they shall not turn away from Me from that day unto eternity.

24 And their souls will cleave to Me and to all My commandments, and they will fulfill My commandments, and I will be their ABBA (Father) and they shall be **My children**.

Jubilees 2:19 And He said to us: 'Behold, I will separate unto Myself a people from among all the peoples, and these shall keep the Shabbat day, and I will sanctify them unto Myself as **My people**, and will bless them; as I have sanctified the Shabbat day and do sanctify it unto Myself, even so will I bless them, and they shall be **My people** and I will be their Sovereign Ruler.

20 And I have chosen the seed of Jacob from among all that I have seen, and have written him down as My first-born son, and have sanctified him unto Myself forever and ever; and I will teach them the Shabbat day, that they may keep Shabbat thereon from all work.'

Deuteronomy 31:11 When **all Israel** is come to appear before YHWH your God in the place which he [YHWH] shall choose, you shall read this law before all Israel in their hearing.

Deuteronomy 31:12 Gather **the people** together, men, and women, and children, and **your stranger** that is within your gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear YHWH your God, and observe to do all the words of this law:

Deuteronomy 30:6 And **YHWH your God will circumcise your heart**, and the heart of your seed, to love YHWH your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, that you may live.



Joshua 21:45 There failed not ought of any good thing which YHWH had spoken unto the house of Israel; all came to pass.

- **2 Samuel 3:18** Now then do it: for YHWH has spoken of David, saying, By the hand of my servant David I will save **my people** Israel out of the hand of the Philistines, and out of the hand of all their enemies.
- **2 Samuel 7:8** Now therefore so shall you say unto my servant David, Thus says YHWH of hosts, I took you from the sheepcote, from following the sheep, to be ruler over **my people**, over Israel:
- **2 Samuel 7:9** And I was with you whithersoever you went, and have cut off all your enemies out of your sight, and have made you a great name, like unto the name of the great men that are in the earth.
- **2 Samuel 7:10** Moreover I will appoint a place for **my people** Israel, and will plant them, that they may dwell in a place of their own, and move no more; neither shall the children of wickedness afflict them anymore, as beforetime,
- **2 Samuel 7:11** And as since the time that I commanded judges to be over **my people** Israel, and have caused you to rest from all your enemies. Also YHWH tells you that he will make you an house.

Psalms 78:1 Give ear, O **my people**, to my law: incline your ears to the words of my mouth.

Psalms 81:8 Hear, O my people, and I will testify unto you: O Israel, if you wilt hearken unto me;

Psalms 81:10 I am YHWH your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt: open your mouth wide, and I will fill it.

Psalms 81:11 But my people would not hearken to my voice; and Israel would have none of me.

Psalms 81:12 So I gave them up unto their own hearts' lust: and they walked in their own counsels.

Psalms 81:13 Oh that my people had hearkened unto me, and Israel had walked in my ways!

Proverbs 29:18 Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keeps the law, happy is he.

Isaiah 30:9 That this is a rebellious people, lying children, children that will not hear the law of YHWH:

Isaiah 51:2 Look unto Abraham your father, and unto Sarah that bare you: **for I called him alone**, and blessed him, and increased him.

Isaiah 51:3 For YHWH shall comfort Zion: he will comfort all her waste places; and he will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of YHWH; joy and gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, and the voice of melody.

Isaiah 51:4 Hearken unto me, my people; and give ear unto me, O my nation: for a law shall proceed from me, and I will make my judgment to rest for a light of the people.

Isaiah 51:5 My righteousness is near; my salvation is gone forth, and mine arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait upon me, and on mine arm shall they trust.

Isa 49:1 Listen, O isles, unto me; and hearken, you people, from far; YHWH has called me from the womb; from the bowels of my mother has he made mention of my name.

Isa 49:2 And he has made my mouth like a sharp sword; in the shadow of his hand has he hid me, and made me a polished shaft; in his guiver has he hid me;

Isa 49:3 And said unto me, You [are] my servant, O Israel, in whom I will be glorified.

Isa 49:4 Then I said, I have labored in vain, I have spent my strength for naught, and in vain: [yet] surely my judgment [is] with YHWH, and my work with my Elohaym.

Isa 49:5 And now, says YHWH that formed me from the womb [to be] his servant, to bring Jacob again to him, Though Israel be not gathered, yet shall I be glorious in the eyes of YHWH, and my Elohaym shall be my strength.

Isa 49:6 And he said, It is a light thing that you should be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give you for a light to the Gentiles, that you may be my salvation unto the end of the earth.

Isa 49:7 Thus says YHWH, the Redeemer of Israel, [and] his Holy One, to him whom man despises, to him whom the nation abhors, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of YHWH that is faithful, [and] the Holy One of Israel, and he shall choose you.

Isa 49:8 Thus says YHWH, In an acceptable time have I heard you, and in a day of salvation have I helped you: and I will preserve you, and give you for a covenant of the people, to establish the earth, to cause to inherit the desolate heritages;

Isa 49:9 That you may say to the prisoners, Go forth; to them that [are] in darkness, Shew yourselves. They shall feed in the ways, and their pastures [shall be] in all high places.

Isa 49:10 They shall not hunger nor thirst; neither shall the heat nor sun smite them: for he that has mercy on them shall lead them, even by the springs of water shall he guide

them.

Isa 49:11 And I will make all my mountains a way, and my highways shall be exalted.



Isa 49:12 Behold, these shall come from far: and, lo, these from the north and from the west; and these from the land of Sinim.

Isa 49:13 Sing, O heavens; and be joyful, O earth; and break forth into singing, O mountains: for YHWH has comforted his people, and will have mercy upon his afflicted.

Jeremiah 4:3 For thus says YHWH to the men of Judah and Jerusalem, Break up your fallow ground, and sow not among thorns.

Jeremiah 4:4 Circumcise yourselves to YHWH, and take away the foreskins of your heart, you men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest my fury come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench it, because of the evil of your doings.

Jeremiah 31:31 Behold, the days come, says YHWH, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:

Jeremiah 31:32 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, says YHWH:

Jeremiah 31:33 But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, says YHWH, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Jeremiah 31:34 And they shall teach no more every man his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know YHWH: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, says YHWH; for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

Hebrews 8:8 For finding fault with them, he says, Behold, the days come, says YHWH, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:

Hebrews 8:9 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, says the Lord.

Hebrews 8:10 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says YHWH; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:

Hebrews 8:11 And they shall not teach every man his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest.

Hebrews 8:12 For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.

Hebrews 8:13 In that he says, A new covenant, he has made the first old. Now that which decays and waxes old is ready to vanish away.

Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because you have rejected knowledge, I will also reject you, that you shall be no priest to me: seeing you hast forgotten the law of your God, I will also forget your children.

Matthew 2:6 And you Bethlehem, in the land of Juda, are not the least among the princes of Juda: for out of you shall come a Governor, that shall rule **my people** Israel.

Acts 2:36 Therefore let all the **house of Israel** know assuredly, that YHWH has made that same Yahusha, whom you have crucified, both Master and anointed.

Acts 7:32 Saying, I am YHWH the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. Then Moses trembled, and durst not behold.

Acts 7:33 Then said YHWH to him, Put off your shoes from your feet: for the place where you stand is holy ground.

Acts 7:34 I have seen, I have seen the affliction of **my people** which is in Egypt, and I have heard their groaning, and am come down to deliver them. And now come, I will send you into Egypt.

Acts 7:35 This Moses whom they refused, saying, Who made you a ruler and a judge? the same did YHWH send to be a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the angel which appeared to him in the bush.

Romans 9:22 What if YHWH, willing to show his wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction:

Romans 9:23 that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory,

Romans 9:24 Even us, whom he has called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?

Romans 9:25 As he says also in Hosea 2:23, I will call them **my people**, which were not **my people**; and her beloved, which was not beloved.

Romans 9:26 And it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, You are not my people; there shall they be called the children of the living God.

Romans 9:27 Isaiah also cries concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be saved:

2 Corinthians 6:14 Be not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship has righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion has light with darkness?2 Corinthians 6:15 And what concord has the anointed with Belial? or what part has he that believes with an infidel?



- **2 Corinthians 6:16** And what agreement has the temple of YHWH with idols? for you are the temple of the living God; as YHWH has said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be **my people**.
- **2 Corinthians 6:17** Wherefore come out from among them, and be separate, says YHWH, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,
- **2 Corinthians 6:18** And will be a Father unto you, and you shall be my sons and daughters, says YHWH Almighty.

Revelation 18:2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

Revelation 18:3 For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.

Revelation 18:4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, **my people**, that you be not partakers of her sins, and that you receive not of her plagues. **Revelation 18:5** For her sins have reached unto heaven, and YHWH has remembered her iniquities.

Revelation 12:16 And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon cast out of his mouth.

Revelation 12:17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of YHWH, and have the testimony of Yahusha the Messiah.

Revelation 22:13 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

Revelation 22:14 Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

Revelation 22:15 For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and makes a lie.

Revelation 22:16 I Yahusha have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star.

Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of the Messiah: for it is the power of YHWH unto salvation to everyone that believes; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Romans 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of YHWH revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

Romans 1:18 For the wrath of YHWH is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness;

Romans 1:19 Because that which may be known of YHWH is manifest in them; for YHWH has shown it unto them.

Romans 1:20 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and divinity; so that they are without excuse:

Romans 1:21 Because that, when they knew YHWH, they glorified him not as YHWH, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

Romans 2:8 But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath,

Romans 2:9 Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that does evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile;

Romans 2:10 But glory, honor, and peace, to every man that works good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile:

Romans 2:11 For there is no respect of persons with YHWH.

Romans 2:12 For as many as have sinned without law shall also perish without law: and as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law;

Romans 2:13 (For not the hearers of the law are just before YHWH, but the doers of the law shall be justified.

Romans 2:28 For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither is that circumcision, which is outward in the flesh:

Romans 2:29 But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of YHWH.

Romans 3:1 What advantage then has the Jew? or what profit is there of circumcision?

Romans 3:2 Much every way: chiefly, because that unto them were committed the oracles of YHWH.

Romans 3:3 For what if some did not believe? shall their unbelief make the faith of YHWH without effect?

Romans 3:4 YHWH forbid: yea, let YHWH be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That you might be justified in your sayings, and might overcome when you are judged.

Romans 3:5 But if our unrighteousness commend the righteousness of YHWH, what shall we say? Is YHWH unrighteous who takes vengeance? (I speak as a man)



Romans 10:12 For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Adonai over all is rich unto all that call upon him.

Galatians 3:26 For you are all **the children of YHWH** by faith in the anointed Yahusha.

Galatians 3:27 For as many of you as have been baptized into the anointed have put on the anointed.

Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for you are all one in the anointed Yahusha.

Galatians 3:29 And if you be the anointed's, then are you Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Colossians 3:10 And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:

Colossians 3:11 Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: but the anointed is all, and in all.

Colossians 3:12 Put on therefore, as the elect of YHWH, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;
